## It's National Dairy Month!

There was more dairy than consumer demand in 1937 when National Dairy Month began. What started as an initiative to gain more milk drinkers turned into an annual celebration of dairy industry contributors worldwide.

Containing essential nutrients like calcium, potassium, protein, riboflavin, niacin, vitamins D and B12 and phosphorus, milk is a great contribution to overall body health.

In honor of Dairy Month, here are some fun facts:



- In ancient Egypt milk and dairy products were a privilege only for the royal and wealthy.
- Pasteurization was a process invented in 1862 by Louis Pasteur that destroys pathogens with heat, which makes milk safe for consumption.
- The first milk bottle was invented in New York state in 1884 and plastic-coated paper milk cartons were invented in the 1930s.
- A Centrifugal Separator is a rotational machine used to separate cream from the skim milk by centrifugal force.
- A Babcock test, which determines the proportion of butterfat in milk and milk products, began in the 1890s.
- According to WisconsinDairy.com, milk required to make the quantity of each item below is shown after the = sign:

Butter (1 lb.) = 21.2 lbs. of whole milk

Whole Milk Cheese (1 lb.) = 10 lbs. of whole milk

Evaporated Milk (1 lb.) = 2.1 lbs. of whole milk

Ice Cream (1 gal) = 12 lbs. of whole milk

Cottage Cheese (1 lb.) = 6.25 lbs. of skim milk

Nonfat Dry Milk (1 lb.) = 11 lbs. of skim milk

Plain Yogurt (1 lb.) = 1 lb. of whole milk

Whole Milk Powder (1 lb.) = 7.4 lbs. whole milk
