# Canadian Rockies by Rail | Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

- Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S. I ARRIVE IN VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA Upon arrival an Orbridge Expedition Leader will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. Later, join the group for a welcome reception. Overnight: Fairmont Hotel Vancouver (R)
- Day 2: VANCOUVER Set out for guided touring of Vancouver and Gastown followed by free time to explore Granville Island at leisure. Overnight: Fairmont Hotel Vancouver (B)
- Day 3: VANCOUVER I ROCKY MOUNTAINEER I KAMLOOPS Transfer to Rocky Mountaineer Station to board the train. The Rocky Mountaineer offers unparalleled hospitality, comfort and unobstructed views. Following a delicious lunch, return to the dome car to listen to expert commentary to gain a deeper understanding of the region's history and natural wonders. Arriving to Kamloops, disembark the train for dinner on your own. Overnight: Kamloops Lodging (B,L)
- Day 4: KAMLOOPS I ROCKY MOUNTAINEER I BANFF, ALBERTA Re-board the train heading east to Banff. Throughout the day, engage in insightful lectures or simply revel in the passing scenery. Disembark in Banff and transfer to your mountain retreat with breathtaking views.

Overnight: The Rimrock Resort Hotel (B,L)

Day 5: BANFF After breakfast ascend to the summit of Sulphur Mountain during a scenic gondola ride. At the top, visit the interactive interpretive center and the Sulphur Mountain Boardwalk, capture photos from the observation deck, or grab a snack at one of the restaurants. Returning to the base of the mountain by gondola, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Following an exciting day of exploration, take advantage of the hotel's luxurious amenities including a fitness room, and indoor pool and hot tub.

Enjoy two nights in delightful Victoria—British Columbia's picture-perfect capital. Savor the island's relaxing pace as you explore vibrant gardens, admire historical architecture, and take in the city's friendly ambience.

#### Day +1: ARRIVE IN VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA Settle into your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Explore some of Victoria's most beautiful downtown sites, including: Christ Church Cathedral, with its gothic stone architecture, magnificent stained glass windows and Helmuth Wolff organ; Craigdarroch Castle, a stunning Victorian mansion; Bastion Square, site of the original Fort Victoria, with its spectacular views of the local harbor; or the renowned Royal British Columbia. Overnight: Fairmont Empress

Day +2: VICTORIA After a light breakfast join your guide for an easy walking tour of Victoria, featuring samplings of delicious local foods while learning about important sites along the way.
