# Northern Lights and the Wildlife of Northern Manitoba

SEPTEMBER 11-16, 2024

Journey to the great Canadian north for a once-in-a-lifetime eco-adventure, featuring evenings under the stars to observe the northern lights.

# Polar Bears & Beluga Whales

JULY 26 - AUGUST 1, 2024

With beluga whales filling the bay and polar bears roaming the shoreline, summer is the perfect time to visit Churchill.


