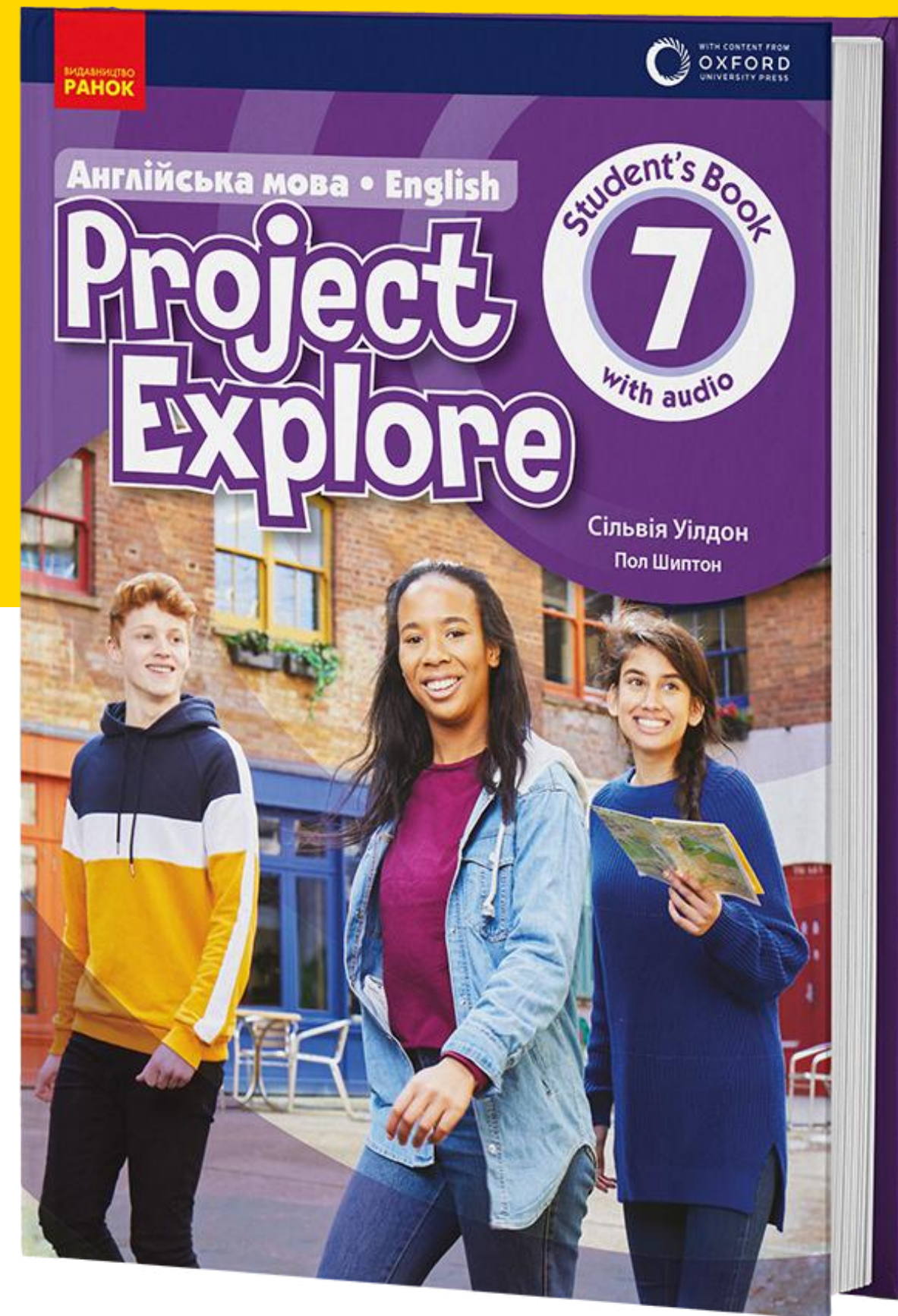

Pronouns



1

personal

I/me, you, they/them, he/him, she/her, it, we/us

2

relative

that, what, which, who, whom, whose

3

demonstrative

this, that, these, those

4

indefinite

some, any, + ...

5

reflexive

myself, yourself/yourselves, themselves, herself, himself, oneself, itself, ourselves

6

intensive

myself, yourself/yourselves, themselves, herself, himself, oneself, itself, ourselves

7

interrogative

what, which, who, whose

8

reciprocal

each other, one another

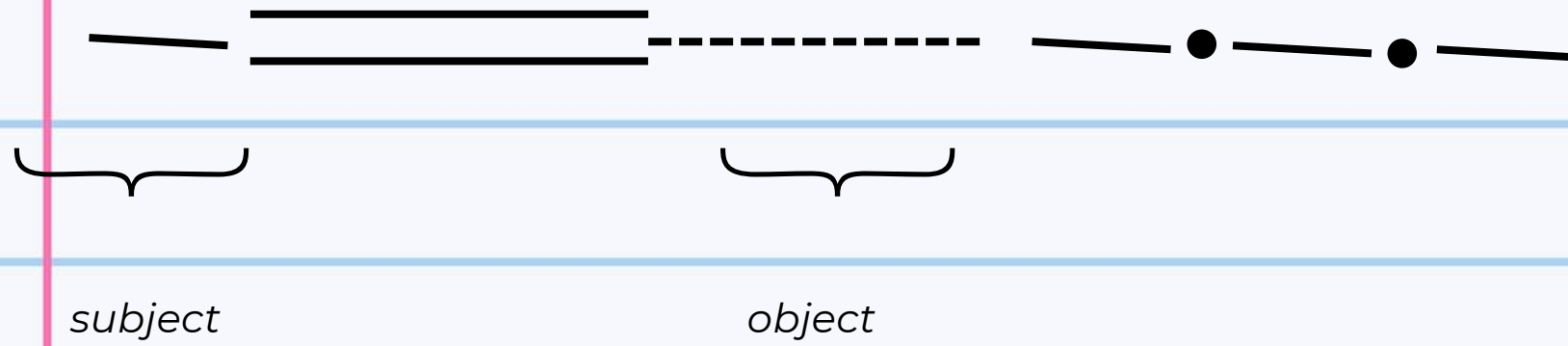
9

distributive

either, each, neither, any, none

We use a reflexive pronoun when the subject and object of the sentence are the same.

She has cut herself.




