For 95 years, Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle (BGCNR) has been an integral part of the community, providing achievement-driven programs encompassing academics, mental wellness, fitness, leadership, and civics. We're one of Westchester County's largest nonprofits and a leader in youth development, serving over 8,000 young people at 12 school sites and two clubhouses in Larchmont, Mamaroneck, and New Rochelle.

For every child enrolled in an afterschool program, three are waitlisted.

BGCNR continually works to expand the scope and reach of our after-school offerings, as well as our before-school programming, electives, and summer camp, to bridge the gap between school and home for working families.






We owe our success to partnerships with government and community leaders, donors, volunteers, and mission-aligned organizations.
Recently, our impact was recognized via a New York State "21st Century Community Learning" grant to build STEM and 21st century skills among 500 middle and high school students; and a "Learning and Enrichment After-School Program Supports" grant to accommodate another 800 to 850 elementary school students in our after-school programming.







We've also recently partnered with The Mariano Rivera Foundation to grow our workforce development and college initiatives, supporting 800 young adults aged 18 to 24.

DID YOU KNOW...

The number of youth we serve has grown from 2,800 in 2021 to over 8,000 in 2024, making us one of the fastest- growing BGCA clubs in the nation

97% of our youth members expect to graduate high school

97% of members try to help when seeing others in need

90% of our youth keep working at it even though a task is very hard

76 cents of every dollar raised funds BGCNR programs, earning us a "highly efficient" rating from Charity Watch

95% of clubhouse members represent diverse ethnicities

81% of clubhouse members qualify for free/reduced lunch

\$100 is our annual clubhouse membership fee, making the BGCNR experience accessible for youth coming from households with a \$30-\$35,000 median income
