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What is P&C

And why it is vital for our school



The Parents and Citizens Association (P&C) brings together parents, citizens, and teachers in a productive partnership to achieve the best possible outcomes for our students. The P&C helps foster community interest in educational matters at the school, ensuring all parents and carers have a voice in the school community.

The P&C plays an important role in generating additional funds* to help our school improve the facilities and resources that fall outside the allocated school budget. All funds raised go back into making the school a wonderful place for our children.





Over the years, the P&C at Wakehurst Public School has assisted the school in co-funding many school-led projects and initiatives to ensure students have access to quality learning materials & equipment. E.g. new playground equipment and upgrades, interactive whiteboards, iPads, classroom air-conditioning, literacy and numeracy resources, flexible learning space furniture and library materials.

*The P&C is a not for profit entity and all money raised is spent on school equipment, facilities or programs. Money raised beyond an existing goal is held in trust for future expenditure.

It's not all about fundraising...

The P&C is also responsible for managing:

- Uniform shop
- Canteen
- Ground maintenance including vegetable garden
- Band
- Fundraising and events
- Community and social events
- Communications (Facebook, Website, Sentral and Billboard)
- Accounts (All funds go back into our services and the school environment for our children)







These services rely heavily on volunteers.

This year there was very low participation from the school community with many tasks falling on just a small handful of people. In order for services mentioned above and certain events to continue, we need more parent engagement. Without YOUR help, we might lose some of them.

It absolutely will. One hour can make a huge difference to the P&C and school.


Most of our committee members also work. Plus, meetings are not compulsory, there are other ways to help.

The P&C is not a one-way ticket to endless drudgery. You can choose to help at one event, all events or no events.


P&C co-funded projects in 2019 & 2020

Currently there is one cold water bubbler, next to the canteen/hall. It sounds like there are queues for it in summer. It would be great to have one or two more closer to the oval or play equipment.

Shed or roof over bike racks

To protect bikes on hot days or in heavy rain. Especially as e-bikes etc become more popular.

Stainless steel hot plates and covers for P&C BBQ


The current BBQ needs a cleanup. Stainless plates would stay much cleaner and last longer with covers / lids.

Artwork or ground paintings in playground areas

Perhaps a world map, planets, hopscotch options, any other educational artworks?

Line marking on main oval

The kids would like this however it would take some regular maintenance, estimate would be monthly in warmer months and every 2-3 months in cooler months.

Real basketball hoop in k-2 quad play area

It would be great for the kids to have their own real hoop. There is currently only the play bucket in this area.

Nets on big soccer goals for yr4-6 kids

Kids are constantly chasing balls through the goals.

2x small fold up goals for yrs 1-3

Year 1-3 students often play soccer on the upper oval grass area and currently use the sand pit posts as makeshift goals. Having dedicated small goals will encourage more participation in ball sports amongst the younger children.

Footy posts on top of soccer goal at east end of oval

A great option for students who are keen to practice kicking for rugby league or union.

Long jump pit

Just an idea to add a new sport option to the oval.

402 students17 P&C members7 P&C fundraising events, 4 P&C community events.


If every parent/carer gave just an hour of their time each year we would have roughly over 600 hours of support.
