Timetabled Co-Curricular

Year 7s have a timetabled co-curricular lesson held in House groups. Each week they will undertake a lesson of Service (over 1.5 terms) and a lesson of Outdoor Education (over 1.5 terms).

- The Year 7 Outdoor Education curriculum consists of four activities. These include Outdoor Adventure, Nature & Conservation, Community Project and Forest School.
- The Year 7 Service Curriculum starts with an introduction to service and creating a House community. Throughout the year they learn about different topics such as food banks, sustainability and volunteering and their impact on both a local and global community. They also engage in a number of practical projects such as the Link to Hope shoebox campaign, postcards for care homes, caring for the School environment and the creation of charity stalls to raise money for charity.



On a Monday all Year 7 students will participate in a compulsory lunchtime club. This will be a Year 7 Sport training session for our major team sports.

On a Tuesday, Thursday and Friday lunchtime a range of clubs will be available for students to participate in, there will also be the opportunity to take part in a number of school events such as House Competitions and BAC Week events.

Clubs are selected by the students at the start of each term, students can do the same club for the duration of the year (if the club is available all year) or can choose a different club each term. Students should not change clubs in the middle of a term.
