### *View from the Bridge:* Busy year awaits Squadron in 2025



Members of America's Boating Club-Charlotte enjoyed the 2024 T.K. Moore Fall Barbecue at Merit Mark Point.


About 40 squadron members attended the October 26, 2024, event, enjoying warm and sunny weather.
