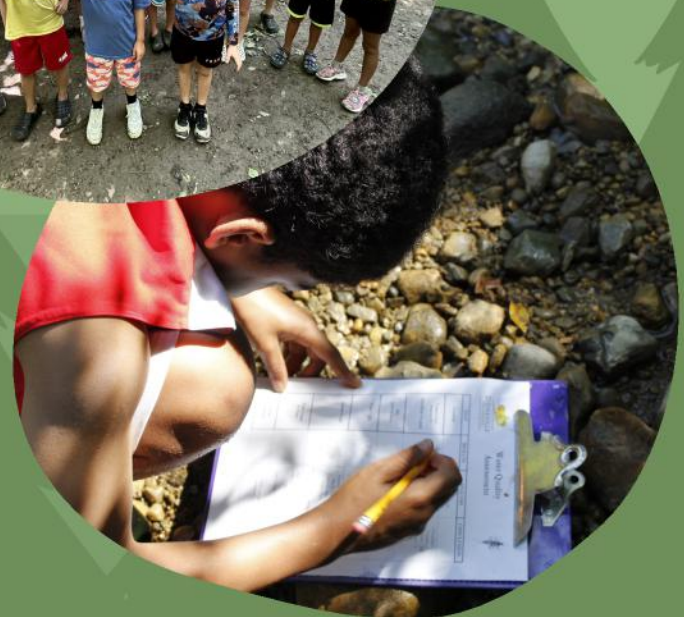

NATURALIST NOTES: EVERYONE CAN BE A NATURALIST

What does it mean to be a naturalist? According to the Oxford Dictionary, a naturalist is “an expert in or student of natural history.” If you’ve ever watched the birds from your window and looked up their species, noticed the pattern of spring wildflowers emerging along the trails of Starkey Park, or planted native plant species in your yard to help the ecosystem, you might consider yourself a student of nature... a naturalist! For some, these casual nature observations are plenty, but for others, a more in-depth look at natural history topics may be desired. That’s where the Indiana Master Naturalist program comes in.

Indiana Master Naturalist (IMN) is a program run by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources that seeks to connect Hoosiers to their natural resources through classroom work, field experiences, and community service. Courses are hosted at various sites across the state with topics focused on biology, botany, soils, conservation, and more. Participants experience lectures from expert speakers, participate in field experiences for learning, and volunteer at natural resource agencies and groups.



Zionsville Parks & Recreation has been a host site for IMN for the past few years, and we are so thrilled to provide this program for adult learners in our community. Nearly 100 people have been through our program since the Department started offering the program, and the demand continues to grow. We have seen firsthand that when people are given the opportunity to learn and grow, they find it inspiring and fun. Participants have had so much positive feedback for their time in the program:

So how can you get involved with IMN? Join our next session! New for this year, we are offering a fall course, starting August 8th, meeting every Friday morning from 9am – 12pm, through October 10th. We are lining up guest speakers and are excited to teach participants about all things birds, reptiles, insects, flowers, mushrooms, and more! And if the daytime doesn’t work for you, we will be bringing back our typical evening classes in early 2026.

Don’t miss this opportunity to be a true “student of nature.” Those of us who are naturalists are always exploring, never stop learning, and always having fun!

SHELTER RESERVATIONS

Zionsville parks are ideal locations for parties, meetings, reunions, weddings or picnics. Reservable shelters allow for exclusive use of park shelters for a prearranged period. Reservations may not extend beyond the current calendar year.

Reservation Policies

- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted. This ordinance is strictly enforced.
- Permission for amplified sound may be revoked at any time if deemed disruptive.
- User groups may not sell food, beverages, or any items in the park.
- If this reservation is part of a fundraiser for a local non-profit, or fundraising for any other purpose please contact parks@zionsville-in.gov Fundraising activities require Park Board approval in advance.
- At the end of the reservation period, the reservation holder must leave the designated space in the same condition as found. Town staff will inspect shelters at the end of the reserved period or at the beginning of the following day. Reservation holders are responsible for all damages to park property and/or trash disposal.
- Refunds may be approved if received one week prior to the reservation date. A \$10 processing fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- If others will not yield your reserved area when requested, please contact Zionsville Police Department at the non-emergency number: 317-873-5967
- Non-profit groups may schedule reservations within Town facilities at a reduced or waived rate.

Residential Rate:

Half day: \$50, Full day: \$100

Nonresidential Rate:

Half day: \$65, Full day: \$130

Half-days are defined by these two shifts

AM Shift: 7:00 am - 2:00 pm

PM Shift: 3:00 - 10:00 pm

- On-site port-o-john, water station
- Playground, basketball court, bocce court



Lincoln Park Gazebo - 100 W Oak Street

- Two picnic tables, electric outlet
- No nearby public restrooms
- **Lincoln Park will be CLOSED September 2025 - Spring 2026 for construction**



Mulberry Fields - 9645 Whitestown Road

Shelter A

- Moveable picnic tables, electric outlet
- Water station, on-site public restrooms
- **Closed in 2025 for construction**

Shelter B

- Moveable picnic tables, electric outlet, grill
- Water station, on-site public restrooms
- Close proximity to pickleball courts

Shelter C

- Moveable picnic tables, electric outlet, grill
- Close proximity to restrooms, splash pad, playground

Shelter A and B

- Moveable picnic tables, electric outlet, grill
- Water station, on-site port-o-john
- Playground



HERITAGE TRAIL DOG PARK

The Heritage Trail Dog Park is approximately 3.5 acres and has separate areas for small and large dogs. Amenities on-site include benches, shade areas, pet waste stations, a water fountain with a dog bowl attachment, picnic shelters, and paved walking trails. Dog park hours are from dawn to dusk, 365 days a year. All dogs must be registered and current on vaccinations. Membership is valid for one year.

Residential Fees:

\$75/yr first dog
\$50/yr additional dogs
(limit 3 dogs/household)

Nonresidential Fees:

\$120/yr (no multiple dog discount)

Fees are reinvested to cover ongoing dog park costs including turf maintenance, security infrastructure and equipment replacement.
