Exodus 20:15 (TEV)

15 "Do not **steal**.

1 Corinthians 6:10 (TEV)

¹⁰ or who steal or are greedy or are drunkards or who slander others or are thieves—none of these will possess God's Kingdom.

Colossians 3:22-23 (TEV)

²² Slaves, obey your human masters in all things, not only when they are watching you because you want to gain their approval; but do it with a sincere heart because of your reverence for the Lord. ²³ Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as though you were working for the Lord and not for people.

James 5:4 (NLT2)

⁴ For listen! Hear the cries of the field workers whom you have cheated of their pay. The wages you held back cry out against you. The cries of those who harvest your fields have reached the ears of the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

Mark 12:40 (NLT2)

Acts 20:33-35 (NLT2)

33 “I have never coveted anyone’s silver or gold or fine clothes. 34 You know that these hands of mine have worked to supply my own needs and even the needs of those who were with me. 35 And I have been a constant example of how you can help those in need by working hard. You should remember the words of the Lord **ἰσχυρῶς: ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive.’”**
