Each rodeo performance will see event winners and money paid out each day. Competition starts with a clean slate each day including Finals Sunday where the highest scores and the fastest times will be Crowned Champion!

Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding and Bull Riding: Top six scores from each of six qualifying performances advance to one of three semifinal performances. Top four from each semifinal advance to Finals Sunday. Highest score wins.

Barrel Racing and Breakaway Roping: Top six times from each of six qualifying performances advance to one of three semifinal performances. Top four from each semifinal advance to Finals Sunday. Fastest time wins.

Tie-Down Roping, Steer Wrestling and Team Roping: Top five times from each of six qualifying performances advance to semifinals. Contestants who do not advance may compete in Wild Card rounds held Monday, July 20, and Thursday, July 23, at 8 a.m. Top four from each semifinal advance to Finals Sunday. Fastest time wins.
