## School welfare assistants

School welfare assistants are on hand to support the families of children attending school in Lausanne in order to:

- facilitate the relationship between families and schools: integration, absenteeism, difficulties at school, etc.;
- support and advise families facing problems at home: conflict, difficult relationships with children, educational concerns, etc.;
- support and act as an intermediary in the case of social and financial difficulties related to school activities.

## Psychologists, psychomotor and speech therapists (PPLS)

Parents who have questions or concerns about their child's development of learning, language or motor skills, or integration and relationships with others, can contact their teacher or the School Psychology Service.
