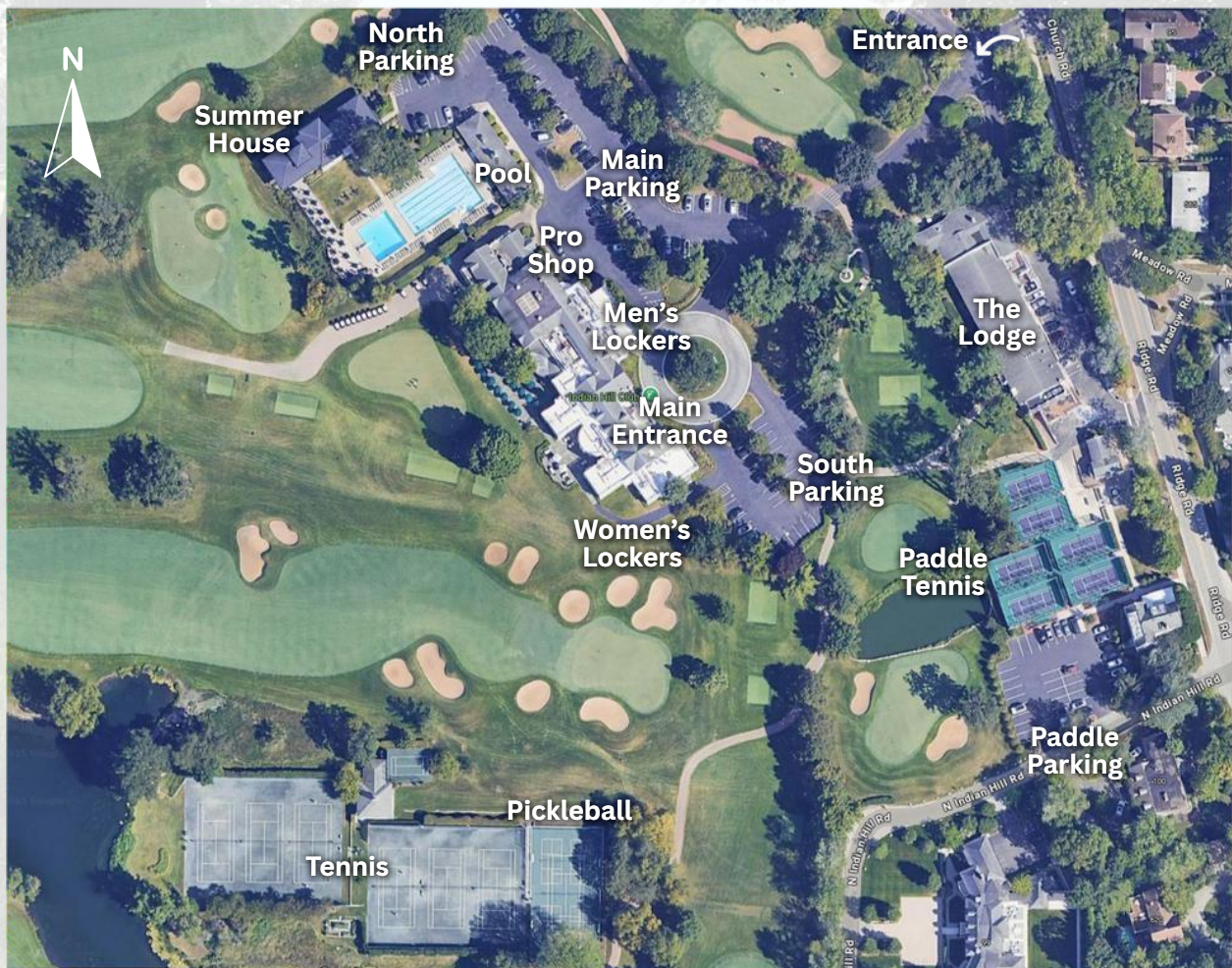

THE CLUBHOUSE



After more than a century of welcoming members and guests, our historic clubhouse has been thoughtfully reimaged. The recent renovation preserves charm and character while introducing fresh, inviting spaces designed for today's gatherings. The clubhouse offers a warm and elegant setting to relax, connect, and enjoy the company of friends.

ATTIRE

To help preserve the Clubhouse's refined yet comfortable atmosphere, we ask that guests remove hats when inside. Spiked golf shoes should only be worn in the locker rooms. Unless otherwise noted, informal attire, including athletic clothing worn in conjunction with golf or tennis, is welcome. Gentlemen are asked to wear a collared, tucked in, shirt with closed-toe footwear while in the clubhouse or on the terrace. Denim, swimwear, tank tops and cargo shorts are not appropriate attire for the Clubhouse.

VENUES

If you are dining with one of our members, you will be seated in one of our many dining locations.

The North Porch is our formal dining room where Gentlemen are requested to wear coats. It is a calm atmosphere intended for an intimate dining experience.

The 1914 is our bar and main dining room. It is an elegant setting with comfortable seating and a sliding glass wall to create a vibrant dining experience. Children under the age of 21 are not permitted to sit at the bar. However, supervised children are welcome to dine in The 1914 dining room.

The Terrace is a favorite seasonal dining venue for our membership and offers picturesque views of the golf course.

The Middle and South Porches & Terraces offer a mix of soft seating for gathering when not being used for a private event. Beverage service is provided.

Summer House and Veranda are located adjacent to the pool and serve as our family casual dining venues. Casual attire including golf, tennis and swimwear, as well as white denim, is acceptable. Shirts and cover ups are required inside the Summer House. The Summer House is open June through September.

The Lodge is our winter family casual dining venue. Wood burning fireplaces provide a North Woods feel. The Activity center gives children a place to play and unwind before dinner. Denim is allowed. The Lodge is open October through April and is located near the South parking lot.

TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES

Cellular Phones & Portable Devices

Indian Hill Club is a place to relax, connect with one another, and step away from the constant demands of technology. While we understand that devices are part of daily life, we appreciate your help in preserving the calm and welcoming atmosphere of the Club.

To ensure everyone's enjoyment:

- Please keep devices on silent mode upon entering the Club property.
- Phone calls may be made or received only in the parking lots.
- Occasional, quiet use of devices (such as texting, viewing photos, checking a calendar, or reading) is welcome, as long as it remains discreet and not excessive.
- Laptop use is reserved for private meeting rooms.

SMOKING

All Club buildings, restaurants, and terraces are completely smoke-free. Cigars are permitted on the golf course.

EMPLOYEES AND GRATUITIES

Employees are valued members of our community and should be treated with the same courtesy and respect given to members and guests. No gratuities may be accepted by any Club employee.

Our Approach to Golf

At Indian Hill Club, we take pride in honoring some of the game's oldest and best traditions, including a steady pace of play and the enjoyment of walking with a caddie.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Upon Arrival – The golf bag drop-off area is adjacent to the Golf Shop on the north side of the Clubhouse. Please use the Main Parking lot while visiting.

LOCKERS

The Men's Locker Room is located next to the Golf Shop.

The Ladies' Locker Room is located at the south end of the clubhouse.

ATTIRE

We appreciate guests helping us maintain the club's longstanding dress traditions.

Gentlemen/Boys: Collared shirts (tucked in) with pants or Bermuda-length shorts are standard. Caps should be worn forward, and hats removed in the Clubhouse, locker room, and outdoor dining area after 6:00 p.m. Open-toed shoes are not worn on terraces.

Ladies/Girls: Slacks, golf skirts/skort, and shorts of suitable length worn with golf shirts or dresses (with or without sleeves) are welcome.

For everyone, denim, athletic wear, cut-offs, swimwear, tank tops, and cargo shorts are not part of our golf attire.

EXCEPTIONS: If you arrive in non-golf clothing, you're welcome to travel between the parking lot and locker rooms to change.

TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES

Cellular Phones & Portable Devices

The guidelines on page 6 are in effect on the course. Please remember to silence your device and keep any necessary conversations short, and discreet.

PACE OF PLAY

We ask all golfers to maintain the pace of the group ahead, aiming for 18 holes in about 4 hours. If your group is more than one hole behind, please allow the next group to play through, a courtesy that keeps the round enjoyable for all.

CADDIES

We have a robust caddie program at Indian Hill. Caddies are valued members of our community and should be treated with the same courtesy and respect given to members, guests and employees.

ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

At Indian Hill, we believe the best rounds are played with respect for the game, the course, and one another. We encourage all players to enjoy their matches with courtesy, sportsmanship, and good humor, no matter how competitive the play.

Gratuities: No gratuities may be accepted by any Club employee.

RESPECT FOR THE COURSE

Please help us preserve the beauty and playability of our course by:

- Repairing divots and ball marks
- Smoothing footprints in bunkers
- Keeping golf carts at least 30 feet from greens
- Calling out a warning if a ball may endanger someone

Leaving the course in the same (or better) condition than you found it is a tradition we cherish.

THE SCORECARD

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION SHALL GOVERN ALL PLAY

LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes, metal "post and chain" fence near roads, metal and wooden fences. The parking lot near the 10th green and the paddle tennis courts are out of bounds.

Obstructions: The clubhouse, swimming pool, tennis courts and tennis backboard, stone wall on #17, and all protective screens are immovable obstructions.

All fescue and tall grass areas are to be played as red penalty areas.

PACE OF PLAY

An undelayed round is an important tradition of this club. Whenever a match shall, for any reason, fall more than one clear hole behind the players ahead, it is expected to invite the following match through. In the absence of such invitation, the following match may go through on request.

TENNIS, PICKLEBALL & PLATFORM TENNIS

UPON ARRIVAL

The Tennis & Pickleball Courts are located beyond the 18th green to the south of the Clubhouse. Please use the South Parking lot to access the courts. Be aware of golfers as you cross #18 to get to the courts.

The Platform Tennis courts are located just west of Ridge Road near The Lodge. Please park in the Paddle Parking lot or behind The Lodge.

ATTIRE

We proudly uphold our all-white tradition for tennis and pickleball attire. Tennis or pickleball-specific shoes (predominantly white) help preserve our courts and ensure safe play. Running shoes are not permitted. If you need proper attire, our Tennis House offers a range of options.

Before Memorial Day and after Labor Day, colored sweatshirts and sweatpants are allowed over white tennis/pickleball clothing.

Platform Tennis attire is at your discretion based on weather conditions.

WATER STATION

Members and guests are encouraged to bring their own water bottles and use the new bottle fill stations at the Tennis House and the Paddle Hut.

TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES

The guidelines on page 6 are in effect. Phones should be on silent and any necessary conversations should be short and discreet.

TENNIS RULES & ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

Please enter courts only between points or on side changes, walk outside fences during play, and keep voices low when near matches. Be sure to collect all personal belongings after play.

SWIMMING POOL

UPON ARRIVAL

The Swimming Pool is located on the North side of the property adjacent to the Summer House. Please park in the North parking lot to access the pool.

GENERAL POLICY

For everyone's safety, children under 11 must be accompanied by a parent or designated caretaker before 6:00 p.m., and under 12 after 6:00 p.m. Children under 6 require "touch supervision", an adult within arm's reach in the water or at the pool edge, even when flotation devices are being worn, which we highly recommend.

ATTIRE

The pool is a family friendly facility and swim attire should be conservative in nature. Blue jeans and denim, cutoffs, and running shorts are not appropriate pool attire.

TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES

We encourage a relaxed environment at the pool. Devices should be on silent. Calls should be taken only in the parking lot. Passive use (occasional and not excessive) is permitted in the Pool area and Summer House.

DIVING BOARDS

One person at a time, and please be sure the diving area is clear before diving. Children must be able to dive independently without jumping into the arms of someone waiting in the water. Lifeguard instructions must be followed at all times.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The Summer House offers food, snacks, and beverages most pool hours. To keep the pool deck clear and safe, food is enjoyed at dining tables or in the grass area. Adults may enjoy beverages on the pool deck; children should consume any drinks other than water at a table or in the grass.
