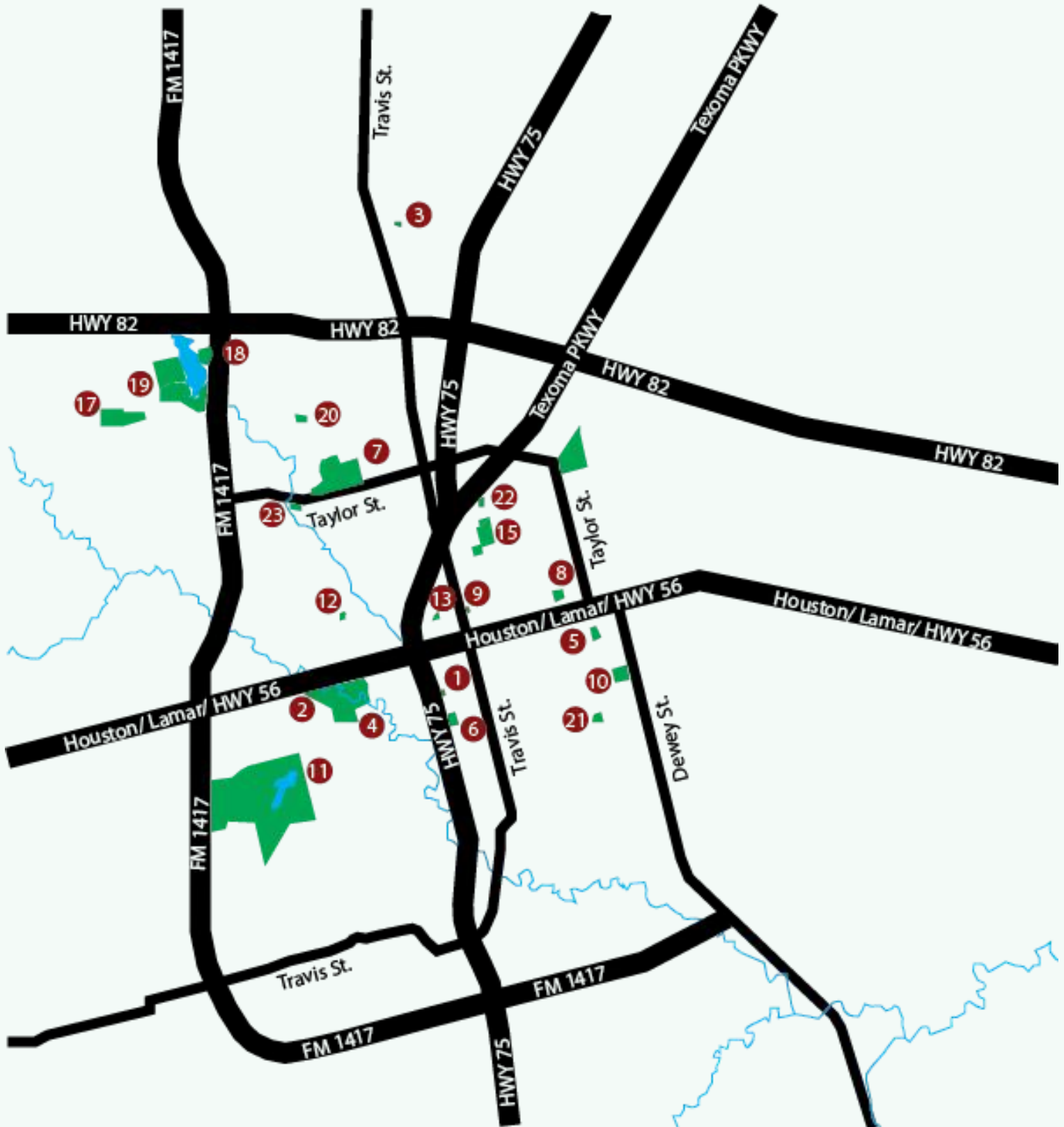

PECAN GROVE EAST

The Grand Opening of the newly improved Pecan Grove East Park took place on April 12, coinciding with the Sherman Parks and Recreation Special Needs Egg Hunt. We take great pride in this park, which reflects significant community involvement in its development.

A key feature of this project is the all-inclusive playground, equipped with a ramp system that connects various areas of the play structure, as well as a diverse range of sensory play elements designed to engage all the senses—sight, sound, and touch. The vision for the play structure was brought to life by a \$115,000 donation from the Sherman Evening Lions Club and the Sherman Noon Lions Club. Additionally, trail lighting has been installed to enhance community access.

A notable feature of the park is the Story Walk, provided by the Grayson County Rotary, which allows children and families to enjoy reading while exploring the park's beautiful tree canopy along a concrete path. In response to the new amenities, we have also expanded the parking lot to accommodate the expected increase in visitors. We encourage you to take the time to explore and enjoy this hidden gem of a park.



FAIRVIEW PARK

Fairview Park has long been a cherished landmark within the community. With its recently renovated playground, it sets an exemplary standard for enjoyable and inclusive design that fosters imagination while promoting equity and teamwork. On March 7, 2025, the inauguration of the new Fairview Park playground was commemorated with a vibrant ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by local leaders and community members, who gathered to celebrate this significant milestone.

The new playground has been thoughtfully designed with inclusivity at its core, ensuring that both children and adults can engage and connect through play. It incorporates features that are easily accessible to everyone, creating a welcoming environment for all participants. The emphasis on inclusivity signifies that every aspect of the playground is intended to inspire imaginative play and collaboration.

For parents, there are designated areas to relax and socialize amidst the park's picturesque green spaces, making it an ideal venue for community gatherings.

The revitalization of Fairview Park is a true testament to the collaborative efforts of the community. FUTSAL DESIGN AT HAWN PARK

Futsal is a variant of soccer played on a hard court, similar in size to a basketball court. This format has gained popularity among soccer enthusiasts due to its smaller playing area and reduced number of players. Recently, the City Council approved the engagement of CEI, Inc. to design two Futsal courts with lighting at Hawn Park. Along with the two Futsal Courts, the project includes lighting, restroom and additional parking. The design process is expected to continue until late 2025, with construction slated to begin immediately thereafter. The anticipated completion date for the courts is projected for the summer of 2026.



PICKLEBALL COURTS AT OLD SETTLERS PARK

During the City Council meeting on March 17th, the City approved the hiring of CEI, Inc. to design two pickleball courts with lighting to be constructed at Old Settlers Park. The design phase is scheduled to continue until the fall of 2025, with construction set to commence immediately thereafter. The anticipated completion date for the project is summer 2026. The addition of these new courts will accommodate the world's fastest growing sport and is expected to alleviate congestion at the popular Fairview Pickleball Courts.

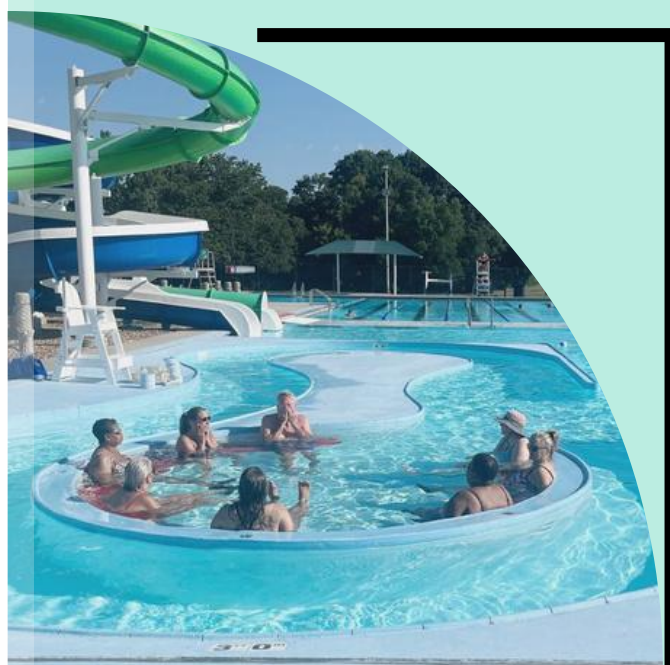

A WALK THROUGH HISTORY

West Hill Cemetery is a gateway to our city's past, preserving the legacies of pioneers, veterans, and leaders who shaped our community. Established in the late 19th century, it offers visitors a chance to walk through history among beautifully crafted monuments and headstones.

One of its most compelling connections is to Olive Oatman, whose story of survival captivated the nation. In 1851, Olive's family was attacked while traveling west, leaving her and her sister as captives. She was later adopted by the Mojave tribe, where she lived for several years before being ransomed back to settlers. Her striking blue chin tattoo, given by the Mojave, became a lasting symbol of her experience and a reminder of the complexities of frontier life. The Oatman family's presence at West Hill Cemetery ties this remarkable story to our city's history.

While West Hill Cemetery remains a cherished landmark, it continues to serve the community, offering a connection to the past while preserving space for future generations.

Students will become comfortable in the water with a parent/guardian.
