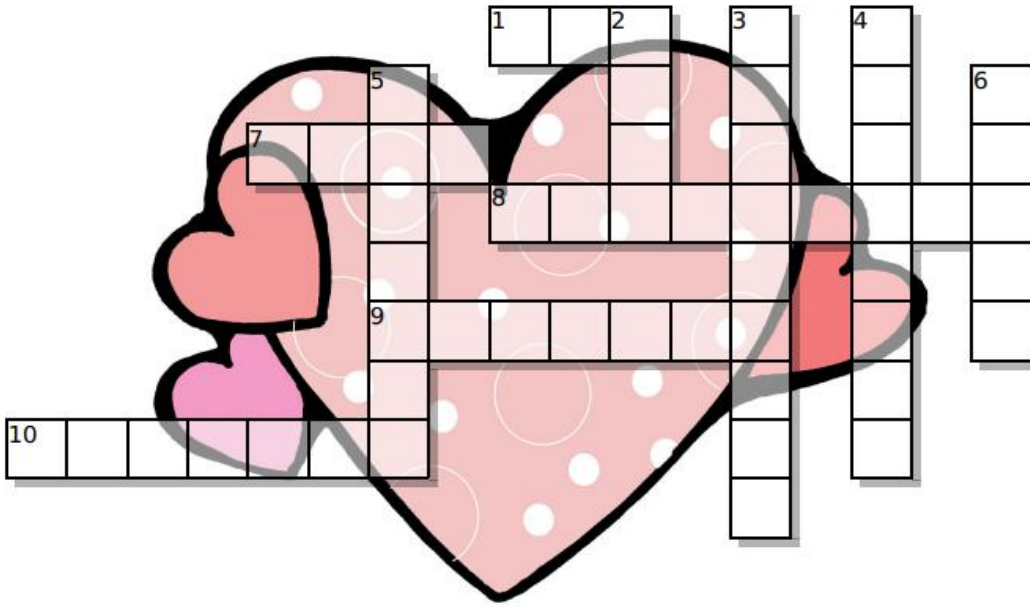

There are many reasons why it is becoming more important to steward our possessions and also protect our wealth and investments. We're not only living ourselves, but we should be providing for our future generations as well. Part of this wisdom involves learning how to protect our lives and property, in addition to right living and a closeness with the Father. I'll be the first to advocate a lifestyle of prayer and fasting – faith that God will protect us at all times. Second to that, I also remind others that in Bible times men carried swords wherever they went. Did you know left-handed men were viewed as "less than" in Bible times, because all swords were mounted on the left hip? (Ehud, in Judges) It's quite a read...

The border crisis is out of control, the current administration is quite literally at the brink of war with Texas. Millions of illegal immigrants have flocked into this nation in droves over the last few years. These are military aged men from different nations around the world. These aren't all suffering refugees. These aren't all oppressed individuals. Some of them are hardened criminals that were released from overcrowded prisons before their sentences were up – and committed vicious crimes such as murder, rape, etc.

The crime rates have skyrocketed around sanctuary cities, and it's causing more damage than what we

This is also why sometimes you see rough shrubbery outside of windows, to deter someone from taking position just underneath one.

There are also stun guns, pepper spray, and firearms to consider. Despite your views on firearms and today's sensitivity over gun rights – it wouldn't hurt to look up your state's laws and ordinances concerning them. Delaware is actually quite relaxed concerning firearms, at least for now. May we never need to resort to such a thing. But if ever a time came, as this climate suggests, we should be prepared.

End Time Qualification

“Then the LORD said to me, “Go again, love a woman (Gomer) who is beloved by her husband and yet is an adulteress, even as the LORD loves the children of Israel, though they turn to other gods and love the raisin cakes [used in the feasts in pagan worship].” 2 So I bought her for myself for fifteen pieces of silver and a homer and a half of barley [the price of a common slave]. 3 And I said to her, “You shall stay with me for many days. You shall not play the prostitute nor shall you have a man; so I will also be toward you [until you have proved your faithfulness].” 4 For the sons of Israel will remain for many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or [idolatrous] pillar, and without ephod or teraphim (household idols). 5 Afterward the sons of Israel will return [in deep repentance] and seek the LORD their God and [seek from the line of] David their king [the King of kings—the Messiah]; and they will come trembling to the LORD and to His goodness and blessing in the last days. (Hosea 3: 1 – 5 {Amp}).

The story of Gomer and Hosea are a true depiction of the love that God has for the Church. The love of God is vastly different than our natural understanding of love. We must retrain our view of love and cause it to line up with God’s view of love. This is a time and a season where the Body of Christ is being drawn out of her many prostitutions and back into love with God. The Holy Spirit is wooing His creation back into His love.

God is asking His body to return to their first love. This means to drop everything that is getting in the way with your relationship with God. God is beckoning for His true children to return to Him. We’re going to see this “returning” occur in many different ways during the next several years. Many in the Body of Christ will have personal one-on-one encounters with Jesus, while others will experience those Jesus encounters in group Church settings. These encounters will inspire those who go through them to repent, give their heart back to God, and yield to being changed forever by His Spirit.

It doesn’t really matter how people return to their first love, it just matters that it is happening. This is not being faked. It’s real. Glory be to God. “We love, because He first loved us.” I John 4: 19 {Amp}

The Word of God says that we love God because He first loved us. This is what we need to hold on to. It’s not any work that we could do. It’s all supernatural. It all comes from the heart of the Father. We have to understand that there are many different types of people that God is going to be reaching. There are those who are easy. Their hearts are soft and tender before the Lord. And then there are those who have been hardened by the world and the things that are in the world. At times God will use drastic measures to reach all types of people. We have to be flexible as prophetic people in understanding that God is going to do what He desires to do, how He desires to do it. Sometimes God needs to use fire and brimstone in order to reach people. On other occasions God can just use a kind word or a soft message, a gentle nudge through the wind in order to gain the heart and the mind of His people. We don’t understand His love and we don’t understand how much God loves.

No matter what God is going to do, what He has set out to do, will be accomplished.

“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,” declares the Lord. “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts higher than your thoughts. “For as the rain and snow come down from heaven, and do not return there without watering the earth, making it bear and sprout, and providing seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so will My word be which goes out of My mouth; It will not return to Me void (useless, without result), without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.” (Isaiah 55: 8 -11 {Amp})

God is fulfilling His plan. He is bringing those who hate the world back to Him. It’s

not up to us to make the decisions on who is coming. It’s just up to us to be available to give those words to His people however they need to be done. You don’t understand or even know what it takes for someone to yield their heart to the Lord. So, we shouldn’t question what God says or how He does it. We should just be willing vessels yielded unto Him to complete the work and the task and the assignment that He placed before us.

When you look at God’s love in many different areas in the Bible, you see a picture of God’s jealousy, you see a picture of God’s mercy, and you also see a picture of God’s consistent, persistent chasing after His people. We see this in Hosea with Gomer. We see this with God the Father and the prodigal. This is a good thing, but sometimes the Body of Christ can take this for granted. Don’t let this bother you. God will sort this out later.

This is the new dispensation that God has been talking about. And with this dispensation comes new ways of God reaching His people. It’s not over. This is just the beginning. New things, new ways, new understandings of how God is going to be ministering to His people. The change that the Body of Christ has been looking for is here. And it’s time that we embrace that change. It’s time that we realize that God has set everything up on His timetable and His perfect will for things to manifest themselves so that He can get the glory.

When you look at the story of Hosea & Gomer you get a clear picture of everything that God was intending to do to bring His people back to Him. His love is so much deeper than we possibly could understand or even imagine. And as we go forth in this hour, it’s just time for us just to receive that love. The more we have the love of God poured inside of us, the more we’ll be able to go forth and accomplish the works that He wants to accomplish.

It’s up to us to just yield our vessels, stop questioning, stop trying to reason it out, and just flow in the Spirit and in His presence, He will make up the rest. He will cause everything else that needs to be added to you, to be added to you so that the works that He needs done can be completed. Remember the Love of God is different than our natural love.



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
