Our Autumn concert series marks the anniversary of three church music icons:

Sir Charles Villiers Stanford (1852 – 1924) an Irishman who became Organist of Trinity College, Cambridge whilst still an undergraduate, later becoming one of the founding professors of the Royal College of Music.

Sir Edward Bairstow (1874 – 1946) had connections with Blackburn, through being the conductor of the Blackburn Music Society whilst holding the post of Organist of Wigan Parish Church. He later moved to be Organist of York Minster, a post he held for 33 years.

Théodore Dubois (1837 – 1924) was Maître de Chapelle at the church of Sainte-Clotilde and then at La Madeleine in Paris, eventually succeeding Saint-Saëns as Organist of the latter. He was appointed Director of the Paris Conservatoire in 1896 where he'd previously taught harmony and composition.

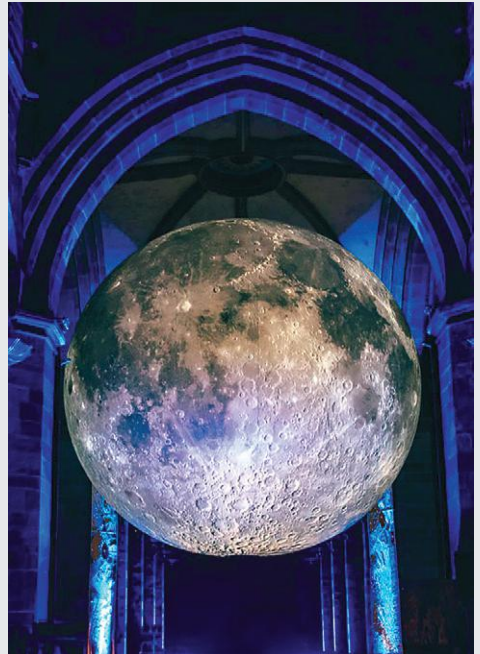
For a truly special experience, why not book to visit in the evening when the installation truly comes into its own?
