

Moneywise: Are You Mortgage Savvy

Last issue we looked at the terms surrounding mortgages. This issue we'll examine three critical decisions home buyers often overlook.

Some simple choices up front can get you out of your mortgage faster and give you more peace of mind along the way.

Fixed or Variable? – Variable interest rates go up and down with the lending market. If your nerves can handle it, variable rates are usually lower. But if interest rates jump, so will your payments.

Fixed rates are higher than variable rates, but if you "lock in", say for a period of five years, you have the security of knowing exactly what your payment will be over that period of time.

Your decision here is based on your risk-tolerance and your ability to stand higher payments on short or no notice. If you're close to the line in your budget, fixed payments might be for you.

Amortization Period – If you can afford a higher payment, choose a shorter amortization period. For example, say you have a \$250,000 mortgage at 5%. If you pay it off in 25 years instead of 30 years, your monthly payment will be \$1,461 as opposed to \$1,342, but the total interest paid drops more than \$40 thousand!

Payment frequency – This is the big choice people often overlook. It can save you a ton of money without any pain, and you'll pay your principal off faster. Instead of making your payments once a month, choose the bi-weekly option, say every second Friday.


Here's how that would benefit you with our \$250,000 mortgage, assuming its 5% over 25 years. Instead of paying \$1,461 a month, you pay \$731 every other Friday. Your interest savings will be \$30 thousand, but TA-DA! Because of the accelerated affect, you will be mortgage-free in 21.5 years instead of 25, and can have that mortgage-burning three and a half years earlier.

What's a Jet Stream?

We often hear weather forecasters talk about the Jet Stream, but what is it? What does it have to do with jets?

The jet stream or streams are fastmoving currents of air in the upper atmosphere.

They generally move west to east in both the north and south hemispheres. They are called "jet" streams because airplanes will follow these currents when possible to save on fuel: sort of like swimming downstream!

Recipe Corner

Veggie Calzones

8 Servings Prep: 25 min. + rising Bake: 35 min

Ingredients

- 1/2 pound fresh mushrooms, chopped
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 medium green pepper, chopped
- 2 tablespoons canola oil
- 3 plum tomatoes, seeded and chopped
- 1 can (6 ounces) tomato paste
- 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 loaves (1 pound *each*) frozen bread dough, thawed
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon water

Directions

- In a large skillet, saute the mushrooms, onion and green pepper in oil until tender. Add tomatoes; cook and stir for 3 minutes. Stir in tomato paste; set aside. Combine cheeses and set aside.
- On a lightly floured surface, divide dough into eight pieces. Roll each piece into a 7-in. circle. Spoon a scant 1/2 cup of vegetable mixture and 1/4 cup of cheese mixture over one side of each circle. Brush edges of dough with water; fold dough over filling and press edges with a fork to seal. Place calzones 3 in. apart on greased baking sheets. Cover and let rise in a warm place for 20 minutes.
- Whisk egg and water; brush over calzones. Bake at 375° for 15 minutes. Cool desired number of calzones; place in freezer bags. Seal and freeze for up to 3 months. Bake the remaining calzones 18-22 minutes longer or until golden brown. Serve immediately.
- To use frozen calzones: Place 2 in. apart on a greased baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 30-35 minutes or until golden brown. Yield: 8 servings.
