

# Lighthouse Foundation Bursary Terms & Conditions

The Lighthouse Foundation Bursary will be offered for the first time in Semester 2, 2024 with the intention of funding residency fees for a first-year resident demonstrating financial hardship.

This bursary is established to provide financial assistance to a student in need, ensuring that talented young women have equal access to tertiary education. The bursary will cover the annual residency fees for one first-year resident for one academic year.

The Terms and Conditions of the bursary are as follows:

## 1. Name and Awarding Body

The bursary shall be named the "Lighthouse Foundation Bursary" and will be awarded by The Women's College based on the recommendation of the Head of College.

### 2. Eligibility

The bursary shall be awarded to a first-year resident of The Women's College who is enrolled full-time at a university in Brisbane.

#### 3. Financial Need

The bursary is intended for a resident demonstrating financial need, who might not otherwise have access to The Women's College experience.

# 4. Residency Requirement

The bursary shall be awarded to a student whose permanent residence is in a regional or rural area, preferably located more than 200km from Brisbane.

# 5. Duration

The bursary shall be awarded for one academic year. It will lapse if the recipient ceases to be a resident of The Women's College during that year.

#### 6. Reapplication

The recipient may reapply for the bursary for their second and third years of residency at The Women's College.

#### 7. Termination

The bursary will be terminated if the recipient:

- is no longer enrolled full-time at a university in Brisbane;
- does not maintain satisfactory academic progress;
- is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
