River Cruising for Travellers with Limited Mobility

iver cruising is a wonderful holiday option for travelers of all ages, including those with limited mobility or walking difficulties. With effortless travel from port to port and constantly changing scenery, river cruises offer a unique experience. However, it's essential to understand the specific challenges and how they can be managed to ensure a smooth journey.

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION

- Air Travel: Airports can be challenging due to the distances and time pressures involved. Assistance, available from check-in to the departure gate, can be arranged in advance. If climbing steps is an issue, lifts can also be provided.
- Rail Travel: Rail options, such as Eurostar, can be a more accessible way to reach European destinations while avoiding airport hassle. However, travel times can be longer (e.g., up to two or three days to reach Budapest by rail). For an elegant and leisurely journey, consider the Venice Simplon Orient-Express.
- **Tip**: Cruise operators may conduct a health assessment to confirm that your travel needs are adequately met.

LIFE ON BOARD

- River cruise ships are designed to fit narrow locks and low bridges, which influences their layout:
- **Corridors and Cabins**: Ships have relatively narrow corridors, and accessible cabins are typically available only in larger, higher-priced categories on modern ships.
- Elevators: Many ships feature elevators, though these may not reach all decks, such as the lower deck cabins or the Sun Deck. Most ships have easily accessible terrace areas off main lounges.
- **Docking Procedures:** In busy ports, ships often dock alongside each other. You may need to cross other ships to reach the shore, which could involve navigating stairs, especially if accessing sun decks.

S WHEELCHAIRS AND MOBILITY AIDS

- Wheelchairs and Mobility Scooters: Most ships are not fully wheelchair accessible, as the vessel's size limits space. Small folding wheelchairs or collapsible scooters can be brought on board but must be stored in cabins.
- Onboard Assistance: Some ships keep a few wheelchairs onboard for emergencies, but these cannot be reserved. Walking frames and canes are usually the most practical mobility aids to use while onboard.

TOURS AND EXCURSIONS

Excursions are a highlight of river cruising, but accessibility varies:

- **Tour Types**: Tours typically involve a mix of walking and coach travel, sometimes over uneven ground. If boarding a coach is challenging, some excursions may not be available.
- Mobility Levels: Some operators offer excursions at different activity levels, allowing you to choose tours based on your mobility and energy level. For gentle walkers, there are options to accommodate a slower pace.
- Onboard Relaxation: For those who prefer a more relaxed experience, staying aboard the ship during excursions is always an option. Many guests enjoy the serene atmosphere onboard while companions explore ashore.
- Tip: Some cruises exclude tours in the base price, letting you select excursions as desired based on your energy level each day.

When is the Best Time to Go on a River Cruise?

Choosing the right time to embark on a river cruise can significantly enhance your experience. Here's a seasonal guide to help you decide when to set sail.

1 SPRING (MARCH TO MAY)



RIVER CRUISES IN EUROPE

Spring is the ideal time to explore the Dutch and Belgian waterways on a Tulip river cruise, with peak bloom in March, April, and May. The Netherlands bursts into color with vibrant tulip fields, windmills, and canals-a must-see bucket list experience. March offers cooler weather and fewer crowds, making it a great time to find deals on European river cruises while still enjoying the same quality in ships, excursions, and service.



RIVER CRUISES IN ASIA

The best time for a Mekong river cruise is during the dry season, from November to March, when temperatures are comfortable and humidity is lower. This is the most popular time, so prices are higher. For a good balance of cost, weather, and fewer tourists, consider traveling in March or April, when conditions are still pleasant, and prices may be lower. Exploring the Mekong on a river cruise is truly a once-in-alifetime experience.



MISSISSIPPI RIVER CRUISES A journey along the Mississippi is a lesson in America's Civil War history, as well as a chance to visit grand plantation homes and storybook towns of the Deep South. This is Mark Twain territory, after all. In general, the best time to river cruise on the Lower Mississippi is from February to early June/late May. Spring offers mild temperatures and is in general the most pleasant times to visit.

2 SUMMER (JUNE TO AUGUST)



RIVER CRUISES IN EUROPE

May, June and September are peak season for European river cruises on the Rhine, Danube, and rivers in France, Portugal, and Italy. Interestingly July and August offer a chance to find lower prices, as some River Cruise travellers prefer to avoid this time of year. Luxury cruise operators enhance peak season experiences with inclusive activities like cycling, guided hikes, and up to four daily excursions, many exclusive. Some even offer kayaking or yoga classes on deck at no extra cost, providing a rich, active experience both on and off the ship.

3 AUTUMN (SEPTEMBER TO NOVEMBER)

Late September to November is an excellent time for European river cruises, offering pleasant weather, fewer crowds, and lower prices than peak summer. The autumn foliage is breathtaking, and seasonal festivities like farmer's markets and wine festivals add to the charm. November is especially ideal for wine-themed cruises on rivers like the Rhône, where you can enjoy local vintages with winemakers post-harvest. As December approaches, Europe's festive Christmas markets begin, transforming riverside cities in France, Germany, Austria, and more. Southern European rivers, like the lower Danube and Portugal's Douro, also stay warmer later in the season, extending the cruising opportunity.

India offers a rich, immersive experience for adventurous travelers, with vibrant contrasts of culture and spirituality. A river cruise on the Ganges isn't for everyone, but for those who embrace India's unique energy, it's unforgettable. Global River Cruising offers a number of cruises in India operating through the cooler, dry season from September to March.



RIVER CRUISES IN THE USA

Mississippi river cruises are divided into Upper and Lower itineraries. Upper Mississippi cruises run from St. Louis, Missouri, to St. Paul, Minnesota, and are best enjoyed in October and November, when cooler weather reduces mosquito activity. Lower Mississippi cruises, on the other hand, peak in spring, offering scenic views and warmer temperatures.

As well as the ever popular Mississippi cruises America also offers other great locations. How about 'New England in the Fall' with the vibrant autumn colours? Of venture to the North West in the footsteps of Lewis and Clarke along the Colombia and Snake rivers.

4 WINTER (DECEMBER TO FEBRUARY)

The best time for a Mekong river cruise is during the dry season, from November to April, with November to January offering ideal conditions. During this period, skies are clear, waters are calm, and the weather is comfortably warm after the wet season.

Beer Gardens: Cologne's beer gardens offer local pilsners paired perfectly with salty soft pretzels, making for a relaxing stop in this lively city.

Heidelberg Castle: Perched above the town, the red sandstone ruins of Heidelberg Castle offer panoramic views of the surrounding valley. The medieval market town below features narrow cobbled streets perfect for exploring quaint cafes and people-watching.

SKOBLENZ

Marksburg Castle: Over 700 years old, Marksburg Castle is a well-preserved medieval fortress offering a glimpse into the region's past.

Confluence of Rivers: Situated at the junction of the Rhine and Moselle rivers, Koblenz is a town rich in history. A must-do excursion is the aerial tram ride from the city center to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, Europe's oldest, dating back to 1,000 BC.

1 RHÔNE & SAÔNE View Cruises

The Rhône flows from Switzerland's Rhône Glacier, through Lake Geneva, and into France, joining the Saône at Lyon before reaching the Mediterranean. A Rhône cruise offers a scenic journey through Burgundy and Provence, regions celebrated for their landscapes, medieval villages, and world-renowned food and wine.


- Arles: Known for its Roman ruins, including Les Arènes arena and the Church of Saint-Trophime.
- Avignon: The "City of Popes," home to seven popes in the 14th century.
- Lyon: A UNESCO World Heritage Site with historic traboules (secret passageways) and stunning views from the Notre Dame Basilica.

Cruising the Rhône & Saône treats travelers to views of vineyards, farms, and castles, with opportunities to explore Provence's markets, villages, and lavender fields.

2 SEINE <u>View Cruises</u>

The Seine River flows from Burgundy through the heart of Paris, winding through Normandy's picturesque landscapes before reaching the English Channel. A Seine cruise offers travelers the chance to experience French art, culture, and history up close.

- Rouen: The medieval capital of Normandy, known for the Gothic Notre Dame Cathedral, painted by Monet, and the 16th-century Gros Horloge clock in Old Town.

The Douro flows 560 miles from Spain to its outlet in Porto, with scenic views of terraced hills, charming towns, and traditional rabelo boats carrying port wine.

The best times for a Douro river cruise are spring (May and June) and harvest season (September and October). Travelers can enjoy local activities, from tasting pastéis de nata in Porto's Mercado do Bolhão to watching flamenco in Salamanca.

A Douro cruise is filled with sightseeing, from ancient castles to Portugal's famous wineries, offering panoramic views and a deep dive into the culture and history of the Douro Valley. For an extended trip, consider adding Lisbon to your itinerary.




