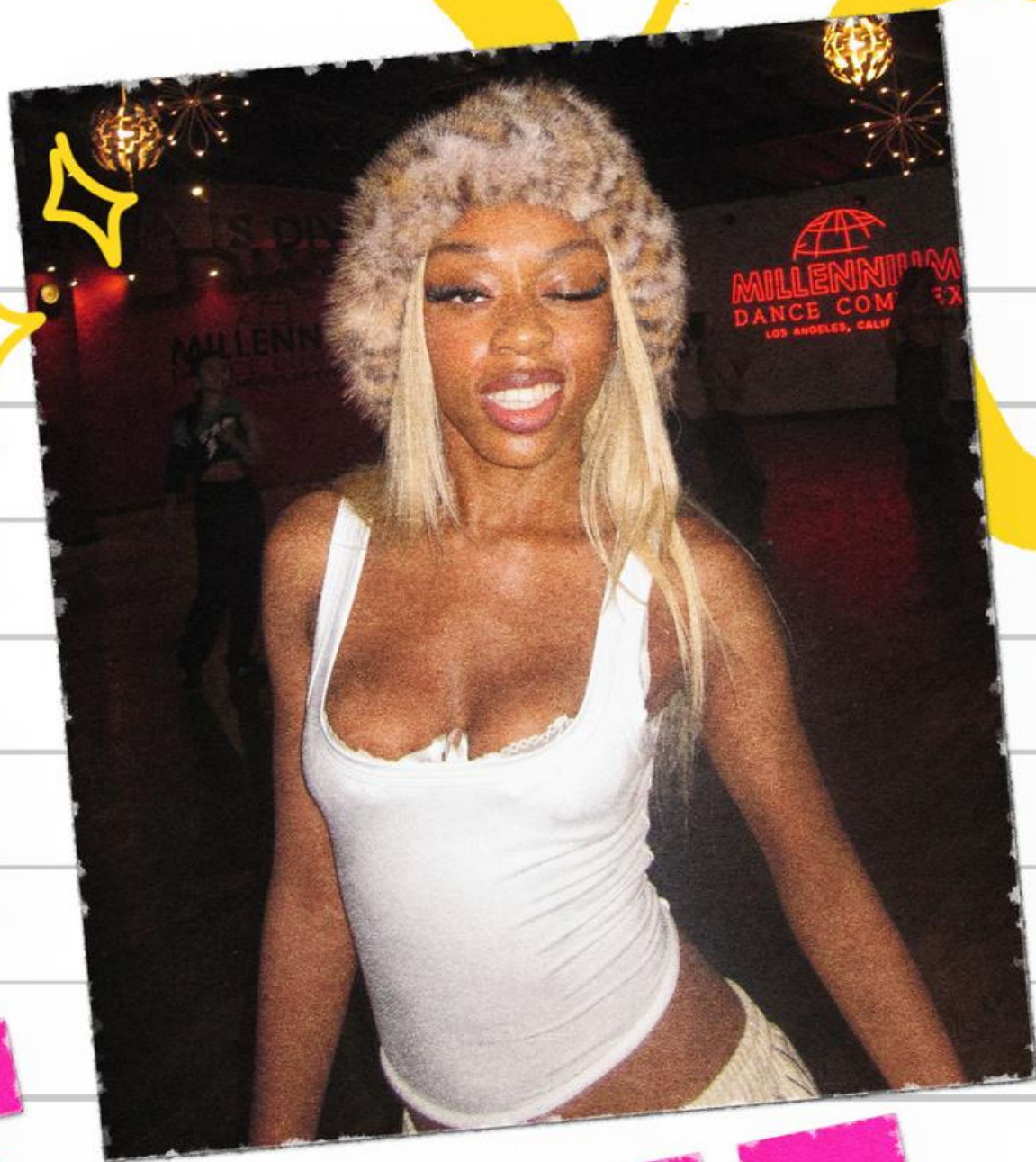


WHO IS VNSA?

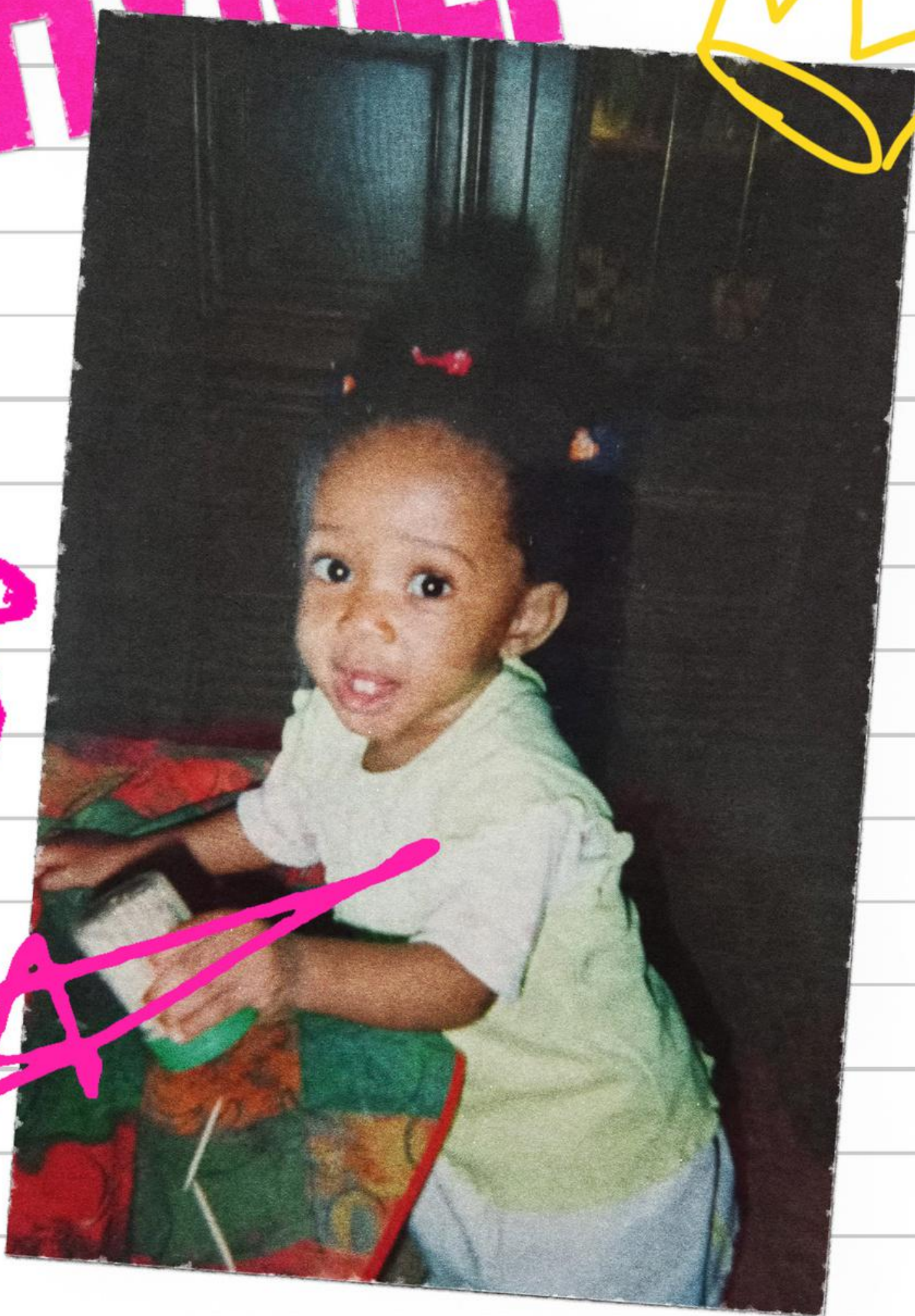


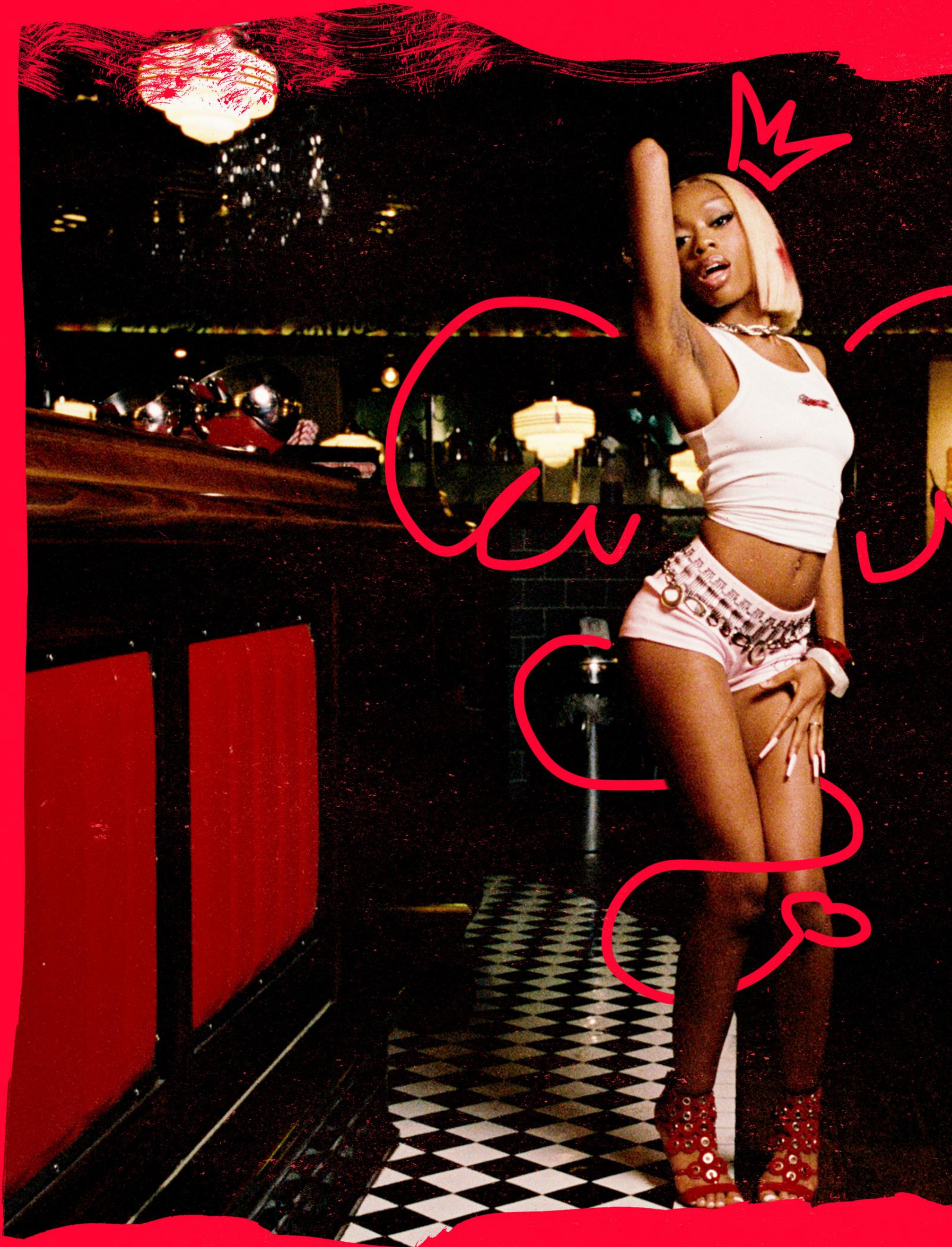

VNSA is a 22-year-old artist whose work stands at the intersection of self-invention and uncompromising craft. Born in Italy and shaped by the dislocation of constantly shifting environments, she found her grounding in music long before she found a stable sense of place. What began in a cramped bedroom evolved into a disciplined practice across studios and stages, where intimate crowds and larger rooms alike became testing grounds for her voice. Her sound—an instinctive blend of RnB, pop, hip-hop, afroswing, EDM, and big-room house—reflects both her multicultural background and her refusal to settle into a single lane. Early support from BBCXTRA, BBC Introducing, Rezz Radio, FlexFM, and London's emerging live circuit has marked her as a rising force within fusion music's new wave. Yet VNSA's trajectory is defined less by accolades and more by intention: a commitment to experimentation, emotional clarity, and the belief that an independent artist can build worlds on her own terms. With each release, she sharpens that world further—sensual, assertive, and distinctly hers—positioning herself not simply as a voice to watch, but as an author of the scene's next chapter.

WHO IS VNSA?

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Keep pushing forward & dont look back.

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SUM REAL SEXY SH*T, or SRSS, is a three-track collection that VNSA positions as both a statement and an experiment in liberation. Conceived, written, recorded, and mixed entirely by her, the project highlights the depth of independent artistry and the intimacy of complete creative control. Each track carries its own emotional temperature, shaped by shifts in rhythm, texture, and tone, yet they sit together as a unified expression of feminine intention. Through bold choices and an instinctive ear for fusion, VNSA constructs a space where sensuality is deliberate, sound is fluid, and the artist remains entirely self-directed.



Across the collection, VNSA moves between sharp lyricism, soft sensuality, and high-tempo performance energy, using contrast as a storytelling tool. The project balances experimentation with emotional clarity, showing how vulnerability and confidence can coexist within the same sonic world. Each track demonstrates a different facet of her evolving identity, revealing how freedom in process leads to authenticity in sound. Rather than conforming to established genre boundaries, VNSA treats SRSS as a canvas where intention dictates form. At its core, the collection champions a simple yet powerful principle: music becomes most compelling when the artist has the autonomy to shape it without restriction.

This autonomy enables her to explore emotional texture without dilution, allowing every melodic shift, every lyrical choice, and every unexpected transition to serve a purpose rooted in self-definition. The result is a project that feels both intimate and architected, a body of work shaped by instinct yet refined through discipline. SRSS ultimately positions VNSA as an artist guided not by trends but by an evolving internal compass—one that privileges depth, clarity, and creative honesty above all else.



Sweetest Girl occupies a pivotal place within VNSA's sonic landscape, functioning as both a thematic anchor and an emotional blueprint for her artistry. It is the track where her instinct for softness becomes a deliberate craft, where intimacy is shaped not by excess but by discipline. What begins as a gentle, melodic opening quickly evolves into a layered

exploration of tone and intention. VNSA uses understatement as a structural device, allowing the listener to lean in rather than be overwhelmed. Her vocal delivery is measured and controlled, yet undeniably expressive—a balance that demonstrates the technical refinement behind her seemingly effortless sound. Through subtle melodic shifts and a warm, enveloping tone, she constructs a soundscape that prioritises emotional resonance over spectacle.

At the heart of Sweetest Girl lies VNSA's ability to merge vulnerability with agency. The track's emotional tension comes from this interplay: the way she can articulate softness without relinquishing strength, or evoke desire while maintaining complete control. This duality is not presented as contradiction but as a natural expression of femininity in its many forms. VNSA's lyrics speak to closeness, connection, and tenderness, yet beneath their surface lies a quiet, strategic confidence. She never leans into melodrama or exaggeration; instead, she builds allure through suggestion, through the careful calibration of tone and pacing. In doing so, she demonstrates an understanding of intimacy that is emotional rather than performative—one that feels lived, thoughtful, and deeply personal.

Her harmonies carry much of this emotional weight. They soften the edges of the production and introduce a subtle layering that feels atmospheric without becoming dense. Every harmony line is placed with intention, acting almost as emotional commentary on the main vocal. This attention to detail reveals how deeply VNSA considers texture within her music. Rather than filling space for the sake of fullness, she uses harmonic movement to articulate nuance, allowing the listener to feel shifts that are sometimes too delicate to be spoken outright. This restraint highlights her maturity as both a vocalist and a storyteller, demonstrating an intuitive understanding of when to withhold, when to reveal, and when to simply let a moment breathe.



Production-wise, Sweetest Girl embraces minimalism not as absence but as clarity. The instrumental framework is stripped back enough to place the vocal at the centre, yet it never feels empty. Each percussive detail, each chord, each atmospheric pad is intentional, forming a foundation that is supportive rather than intrusive. The beat grounds the track gently, offering momentum without aggressiveness. This creates a floating quality—a sense of being suspended between emotional states—that mirrors the vulnerability embedded in the lyrics. The sonic space feels open, almost cinematic, giving VNSA's voice the room it needs to carry the narrative.

This minimalistic approach is a reflection of VNSA's broader creative ethos. She gravitates toward intention over excess, towards clarity of expression rather than loudness for its own sake. Sweetest Girl becomes a crystallisation of this philosophy: a track that prioritises emotional precision, that values subtlety as much as impact. It serves as a reminder that softness can be powerful when wielded with confidence, and that simplicity, when executed with vision, can say far more than complexity.

By the time the track reaches its conclusion, its purpose becomes unmistakable. Sweetest Girl is not merely a love song or a sensual vignette; it is a declaration of feminine agency constructed through restraint, nuance, and emotional intelligence. Positioned within VNSA's wider body of work, it functions as both a statement and a promise—a glimpse of an artist shaping a new emotional language on her own terms. Through tone, texture, and intention, VNSA affirms that softness is not a weakness to overcome, but a force to master.

How You Move Like That stands out in VNSA's catalogue not just for its rhythm or attitude, but for what the track reveals about her understanding of presence as a form of power. Lyrically, the song leans into flirtation, confidence, and the thrill of being unapologetically visible. VNSA captures the electricity of a moment—eyes meeting across a room, rhythm syncing with desire, the subtle push-and-pull of magnetic presence. These fleeting exchanges become the architecture of the track, turning something momentary into something cinematic. Yet underneath the immediacy is control. The seduction is on her terms, shaped by her tempo, her command, her interpretation of what it means to take up space. It becomes less about responding to a room and more about authoring it.

HOW YOU MOVE LIKE THAT

This framing transforms the track from flirtation into a portrait of agency. VNSA owns the way she moves, the way she is perceived, and the way she chooses to invite or withhold access. Each lyric feels like a deliberate gesture, a coded signal delivered with intention. There is playfulness in her tone, but authority beneath it. She uses rhythm as language, shaping her presence through cadence rather than over-explanation, meeting the beat like choreography and bending around it with precision. This is not seduction formed through vulnerability; it is seduction constructed through self-definition.

As the track progresses, this dynamic sharpens. Movement becomes a framework through which she expresses confidence and autonomy. The song understands that a glance or shift in weight can speak louder than words, and VNSA leans into that truth with clarity. The production mirrors this restraint. Crisp percussion and clean low-end create a rhythmic

foundation that never crowds her vocal. Instead, the beat pulses, inviting motion without demanding it. Minimal elements flicker in and out, mirroring the fleeting cues that shape attraction. The simplicity is intentional, reflecting a confidence that doesn't rely on spectacle.

There is emotional intelligence behind her performance as well. VNSA treats movement as communication—instinctive, embodied storytelling. The track recognises that the body holds nuance language can't always articulate: tension, invitation, refusal, curiosity, command. Through this lens, her performance becomes cinematic, capturing charged moments that happen in passing—across a dancefloor, along a bar, in the decision to approach or retreat. Attraction becomes less about perfection and more about the energy someone chooses to inhabit. VNSA channels that understanding with striking precision.



As the second half unfolds, her delivery becomes increasingly assured—not louder, but clearer. She doesn't just reference the moment; she embodies it. The repetition of phrases reinforces the hypnotic quality of the production, turning the hook into a mantra of presence. Each return to a familiar rhythm feels like another angle, another expression of control. It's confidence communicated without excess.

In the final moments, the track eases into a steady certainty. VNSA no longer needs to prove anything. The production softens, giving space for the aura of the song to settle. The lingering repetition feels almost ritualistic—an affirmation of her command over mood, space, and attention. It's the kind of song that shifts the energy of a room not through force, but through attitude.

By the time it fades, *How You Move Like That* leaves a lasting impression: a study in charisma, rhythm, and intentional allure. It stands as a declaration of identity, showing how movement—when owned fully—becomes narrative, power, and musical language all at once.

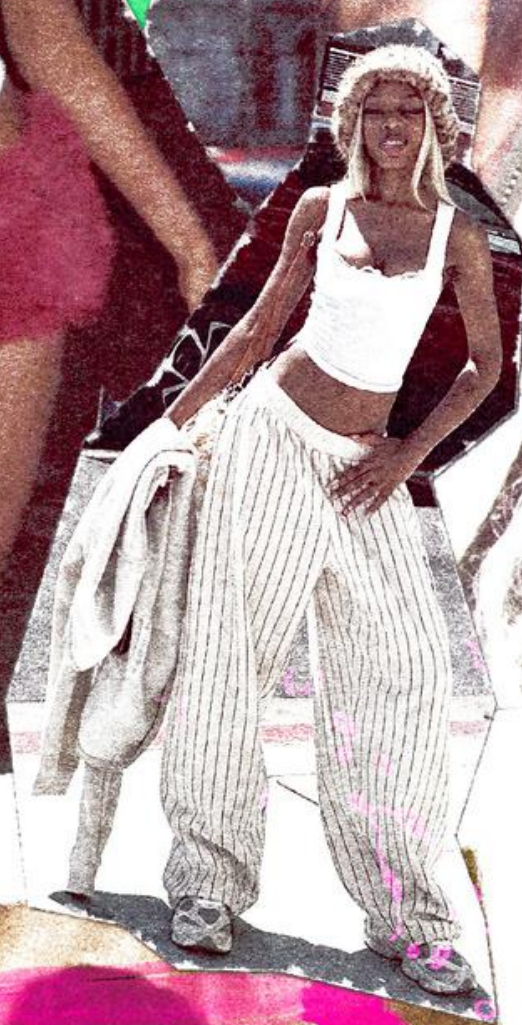

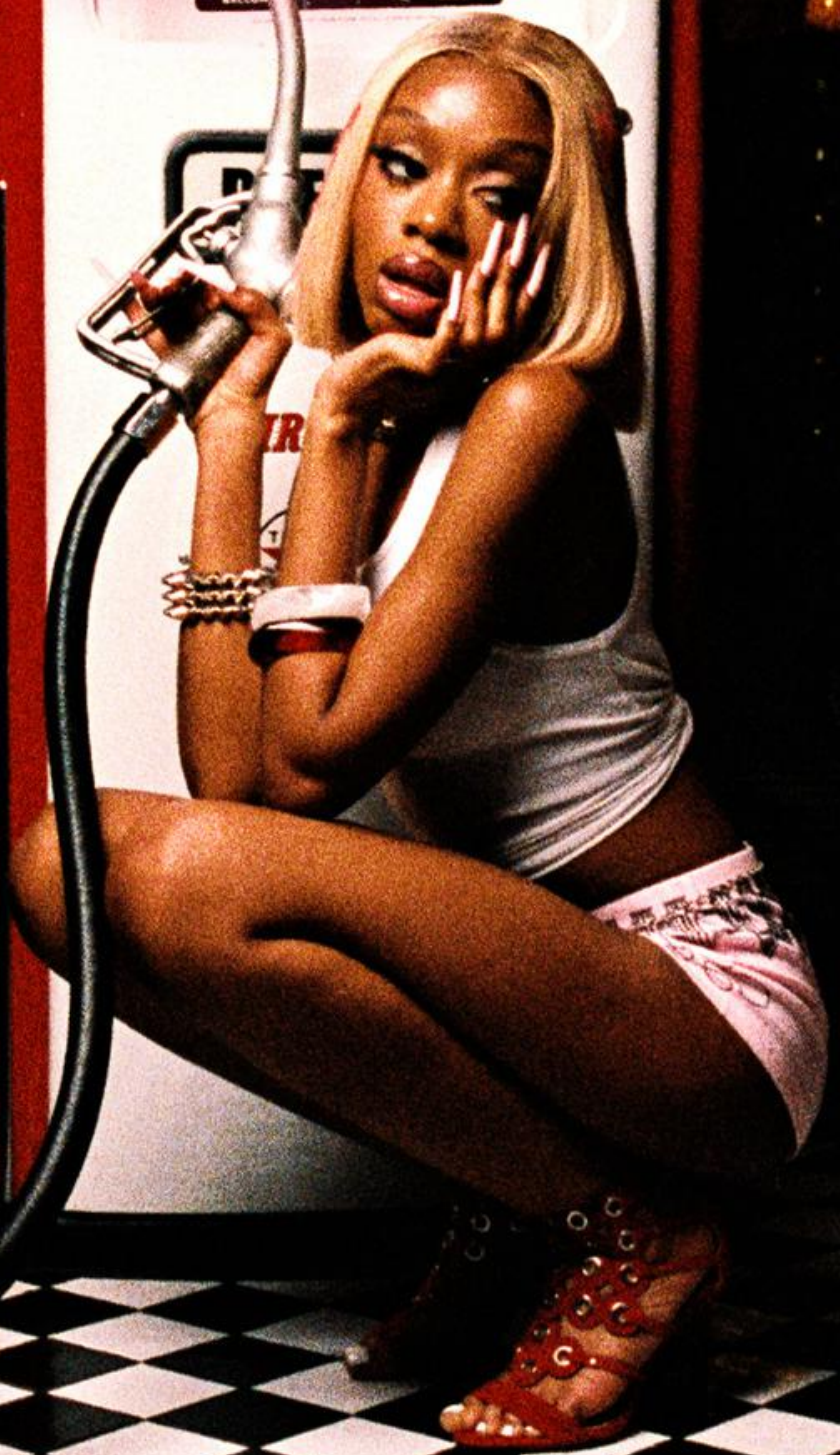
