With over 15 years in law enforcement, he is committed to public safety and holds a Master's in Public Safety Administration and a Bachelor's in Criminal Justice. His dedication has earned him several Life-Saving Awards and The Superintendent Award of Valor.

As the Founder and Executive Director of Youth & Blue United Inc., Carmichael works to bridge the gap between law enforcement and urban youths through mentorship, leadership development, and innovative programs. His organization prioritizes keeping students in school by offering alternatives to suspension and detention through The Pivot Program: Redirecting Students for Excellence & Transformation, a diversion initiative that provides guidance rather than punishment. Additionally, Ignite Your Purpose is a transformative program designed to inspire and empower youths through mentorship, leadership development, and personal growth opportunities. Through these initiatives, Youth & Blue United fosters trust, collaboration, and lasting change among young people and law enforcement.

Beyond his career, Carmichael is deeply involved in schools, churches and detention centers, using his experiences to inspire and uplift the next generation. His mission is to ensure that every young person has the support, mentorship, and resources needed to succeed."

Through programs like the Re-Up Our Future (ROF) Program, created and implemented in 2021, the Re-Up Our Future Scholarship has provided over 65 scholarships to Englewood scholars pursuing higher education. Scholars also receive mentorship and leadership training, ensuring they have the resources and support needed for academic and professional success. The Re-Up Economic Upliftment Program focuses on bridging economic disparities by providing financial literacy education, workforce development, and entrepreneurial support to residents, helping them achieve financial stability and growth.

Additionally, R.A.G.E. spearheads initiatives such as Buy the Block, equipping aspiring homeowners and landlords with financial literacy and real estate knowledge to promote generational wealth within Englewood. Lekeya Shearrill-Powell has a BA in Theatre Education from Illinois State University and a Master of Arts in Teaching from Roosevelt University. She began her career in education as a second-grade teacher, creating songs and dances to teach concepts in Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Five years later, she founded Keys2broadway Educational Theatre company to remove logistical barriers preventing elementary and middle school students from receiving arts programming. Keys2broadway partnered with schools to provide quality onsite after-school Arts programming to every interested 3rd - 8th grade student, ultimately serving over 500 students per year from 2014 - 2020.

Lekeya is currently a Theatre Teacher at Ryder Math and Science Specialty school and is once again immersing students in the transformative power of the arts.

The African American engineering students who came to Purdue University in the early 1970s were small in number, but they came with big dreams. The Civil Rights Movement had brought progress but also unfulfilled promises of social and economic equality. Aspiring Black Engineers at Purdue wanted to see more of their people and their communities empowered by knowledge of STEM.

Purdue undergraduates Edward Barnette Jr. and Fred Cooper teamed with their faculty advisor, Arthur Bond, Ph.D., to launch a campus organization, the Black Society of Engineers (BSE), in 1971. For the next four years, the work of this student group helped significantly increase the recruitment and retention of Black engineering scholars at Purdue.

In 1973, under the leadership of six close-knit Purdue engineering students from Chicago — Edward A. Coleman, Anthony Harris, Brian Harris, Stanley L. Kirtley, John W. Logan Jr. and George A. Smith — the BSE changed its name to the Society of Black Engineers (SBE) and a year later launched an effort to create a national organization to increase the number of Blacks in the engineering profession across the U.S. Letters of invitation mailed nationwide by the SBE drew 134 students from 28 schools to a gathering on April 10–12, 1975, at Purdue, where the National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE) was established.
