Faculty & Staff Request Guidelines

The Committee of 100 is a group of 70 to 100 members that meets every year to consider funding for specific requests from the Faculty and Staff. This is an excellent opportunity to obtain items for your classroom and/or department that may not otherwise be covered by the budget. The Executive Committee ("Committee") is a smaller group that reviews and approves all of these requests before they go to the larger Committee of 100 for consideration. When submitting your request, please carefully read and follow these guidelines:

- Item(s) being requested must align with the Mission of Auburn Adventist Academy ("AAA"), which is to: **Seek** Divine Wisdom (James 3:17); **Inspire** Innovative Minds (1 Corinthians 2:9); and **Build** Eternal Relationships (1 John 4:7).
- Item(s) must enhance the educational experience and/or campus life experience of the students. If the item is not for a specific classroom, it must benefit AAA as a whole (for example, an item used for recruitment or marketing). Tables, chairs, and desks will not be considered a high priority for funding through the Committee of 100.
- All requests must be reviewed and approved by AAA Administration before Committee consideration.
- Focus should be on items that can be used for years to come.
- If a request exceeds \$5,000, the requester may be asked to personally present their request to the Committee of 100 Executive Committee at a meeting scheduled by the Committee. This applies to each request. For example, if you are requesting multiple of the same item, and that total amount exceeds \$5,000, you may be asked to present to the Committee. Note: If you are requesting 5 different items, the \$5,000 applies to each item, not the total combined.
- If a request involves technology, it must also be reviewed and approved by the AAA Technology Committee before it is submitted to the Committee for review and approval.
- The Committee will review all requests that are received by the deadline established by the Committee. Requests received after the deadline may be deferred to the following year.
- Please do not request more than five (5) different items. If multiple <u>different</u> items are requested from a single department and/or classroom, requests may be denied or deferred to the following year (request must be resubmitted the following year if deferred) so that funds may be distributed more equally. If you are requesting multiple different items, please indicate which of those items are a priority for your classroom/department, since it may not be possible to obtain all of the items you are requesting. You may request more than five (5) of the same item (i.e., books, art/drafting kits, etc.).
- A Request Form must be completed for each different item. *If the request is for multiples of the same item, please put them on the same Request Form.*
- Item descriptions must be concise and describe in detail what the item is and how it will directly benefit the students or AAA as a whole. The Request Forms must be fully completed (all questions answered) in order to be considered.
- The Committee of 100 funds are not to be used for transportation purposes.
- Once items have been funded, <u>they must be purchased by the requester by December 31</u> of the funding year, or the
 funds will be returned to the Committee of 100. Purchasing the item is the <u>sole responsibility</u> of the purchaser and is
 to be done within the guidelines of the Finance Office, as instructed by the Vice Principal of Finance.

This light will enhance the lighting capabilities we have by providing a brighter more accurate light for our illumination needs.

Also, music performances, ASB activities, musicals, talent shows, J2B, sports, etc. I document as much as possible and then organize each event into galleries that are used by me for promo materials (brochures and other marketing items), social media, promotional articles, etc. I make the galleries available to yearbook, ASB, classes, and anyone who needs pictures for a variety of reasons.

This product consists of a set of vanes, each with one shiny side and one black side, mounted on a spindle in a partially evacuated glass bulb. When exposed to the sun or other intense light, the vanes begin to rotate with the black side trailing. The black side heats the air next to it more than the shiny side, so the air pushes harder on the black side. The purpose is to support science demonstrations in the classroom.

24. Wireless Smart Gate

The Wireless Smart Gate is a multi-purpose photogate. It has dual photogate beams spaced at 1.5 cm to accurately measure speed and velocity. The built-in laser switch (when used with any laser) allows you to time objects too large to fit through the arms of the photogate. The integrated slot on the arm receives photogate tape that also helps measure the movement of larger and faster objects, like model rockets. To use along with the smart cars.
