COPENHAGEN





CHASING THE AURORA

Europe's best destinations for spotting the Northern Lights

The planet's most spectacular light show, the celestial dance of the Northern Lights (otherwise known as the aurora borealis), has intrigued and enchanted us for millennia. These enthralling, swirling curtains of colour, created by charged particles from the sun meeting the earth's atmosphere, appear annually to bring an extra magic to our northernmost skies in the depths of winter.

Gazing in wonder at the Northern Lights has become a bucket-list item for many travellers but, like much in nature, there is no guarantee that they will appear when and where they are supposed to. For the best chance of witnessing an enthralling show, you need to travel between November and March; it is very much worth the effort! Luckily the very best places in Europe to see them also offer vibrant urban centres and a host of other fabulous winter activities, from geothermal pools to ice caving, so your Northern Lights experience can be as adventurous or relaxing as you fancy.

ICELAND IS HOME TO EUROPE'S LARGEST GLACIER, WITH CAPITAL CITY REYKJAVIK BOASTING AN EXCELLENT BASE TO EXPLORE

An ever popular destination for the Northern Lights, and the majesty of nature in general, Iceland has stark and dramatic beauty by the bucketload. Capital city Reykjavik is compact and lively, and an excellent base from which to explore. With a hedonistic nightlife, excellent eateries and a series of engaging museums, there is much to charm visitors and, with the famous silica-rich hot waters of the Blue Lagoon in easy reach, to relax them too.

Trips to see the Northern Lights can be easily arranged from Reykjavik, but heading farther into Iceland's wilderness makes it easier to watch their mesmerising ballet and gives access to the host of waterfalls, volcanoes, beaches and glaciers. If you choose to visit Europe's largest glacier, you can crank up the exhilaration with glacier hiking and ice caving, whilst from Hella you can visit geysers, black sand beaches and the famous Strokkur geyser.

NORWAY'S TROMSO OFFERS AN ARRAY OF WINTER ACTIVITIES AND ONE OF THE LONGEST DURATIONS TO SEE THE NORTHERN LIGHTS

A third of Norway's territory lies within the Arctic Circle, the long dark winters offering plentiful opportunity to chase the aurora borealis. Vibrant Tromsø has long been the 'gateway to the Arctic' as the starting point for many Arctic expeditions in the early 1900s; here you have one of the highest

probabilities of seeing the Northern Lights on the planet.

Set on the icy waters of a fjord and surrounded by rugged snowcapped peaks, you couldn't get much more polar than this - something

that is reflected in the range of activities on offer. Dog sledding, reindeer sledding and a visit or stay in the Tromsø ice domes offer the perfect winter experiences, whilst cruising the fjord not only offers spectacular views but excellent birdwatching too. With an extended aurora spotting season between September and April, taking a guided tour out into a darker, more remote area gives a better experience, even though it is possible to see the aurora from within the city.



From an archipelago in the high Arctic, Northern Light spotting doesn't get much more unique and adventurous than in Svalbard. One of the northernmost inhabited places on earth (though polar bears outnumber humans!), Svalbard is both awe-





inspiring and unforgiving, with a rugged, snowy and remote terrain that is considered Europe's last great wilderness.

Here, the winters are deep and dark - there is no daylight at all between November and the end of January - and the Northern Lights regularly play in the limitless dark. Stay in the town of Longyearbyen, on the island of Spitsbergen, a bustling little place where you can base yourself to venture out exploring iceberg strewn waters, ice caves and to spot incredible wildlife. After a day of adventures, sample the wares of the

> world's northernmost brewery or warm up with a glass or two from one of Scandinavia's best wine cellars whilst waiting for the Northern Lights to flicker through the night skies.

MENORCA: THE PERFECT FAMILY DESTINATION

SO, WHY IS MENORCA SO GOOD FOR FAMILIES?

It's understated, peaceful, laidback and is steeped in history and natural beauty.

Mornings spent by the pool, long lunches in pretty tavernas and afternoons spent on sandy beaches. Days spent exploring picturesque towns, splashing about in water parks and discovering hidden coves by boat. Menorca ticks all the boxes when it comes to a family holiday.

" A super short flight from the UK, just over 2 hours, it's a relatively easy iourney with kids! //

You can drive from east to west in 45 minutes, and there's just one main road, making navigating a breeze. There are generally not many cars, plus there are no long travel journeys, making exploring much more manageable, particularly if you have young children. "Are we there vet?" You can always answer "Almost!"

THERE ARE MORE **BEACHES THAN MALLORCA** AND IBIZA COMBINED!

My advice would be to explore more than one corner of this idvllic island. That said, be warned perfect beaches exist in all shapes and sizes - and not just the odd one; think Caribbean-aquamarine sea and fine white sand. With 200km of coastline. Menorca has more beaches than Mallorca and Ibiza combined!

Cala Galdana, Arenal d'en Castell, Santo Tomas, Cala en Porter, Arenal de Son Saura and Son Bou are a few of the bigger resort beaches - all with crystal-clear water and an



expanse of soft golden sand, easy access, some with a playground nearby and close to shops and beach bars. The 'calas' or small coves are also worth visiting and ideal for little ones, with calm, shallow waters: Alcaufar, Binisafua and Binidali to name a few of our favourites.



If you prefer something off the beaten track, Cala Mitjana, Cala Macarelleta and Cala Pregonda are all breathtakingly beautiful. The walk along the Cami de Cavalls (Menorca's walking path, which encircles the whole island) to get to these beaches may not be ideal for younger children or pushchairs but certainly doable for older kids, providing you bring enough water and snacks!

THERE ARE SO MANY CHARMING TOWNS AND VILLAGES

The two main towns lie on opposite sides of the island, and I recommend visiting at least one.

Charming Ciutadella lies on the west coast of the island. The best way to explore it is to wander its narrow streets full of traditional pastel buildings, quaint coffee shops and bars, pretty squares, an impressive Cathedral and a picture-perfect port. Head to Plaça des Pins for

a beautiful, shaded playground surrounded by bars and cafés perfect for families.

Mahon, the elegant capital, lies on a plateau on the east coast overlooking the largest natural harbour in the Med. Streets are lined with shops, boutiques and restaurants. Slightly more modern, yet still full of traditional architecture, are a buzzing fish market and a remarkable museum.

The red land train or 'Mahon Express' is a great way to explore the town with kids of all ages. The land train winds down the streets of Mahon and runs along the harbour in a 45-minute loop that you can hop on and hop off as you please.

Another favourite activity is the glass bottom boat cruise heading out into the mouth of the harbour.

If you're seeking authentic villages, Fornells, an old fishing harbour in the north famed for its lobster stew, is worthy of your time. As is the pretty Cala Fonts of Es Castell, a tiny harbour where you can dine on fresh seafood and sip a Pomada. Binibeca Vell should also top the list, a labyrinth of white-washed villas built in the 1970s to resemble a fishing village.

Step outside the main centres and you'll find a patchwork of green fields enclosed by ancient dry stone walls, pretty white houses and fincas selling traditional Mahon cheese and spicy Sobrasada sausage. The odd surprise is also in store. Lithica, a former quarry

turned open-air stone museum, complete with a limestone maze, is one of them. Talati de Dalt, reminiscent of Stonehenge, one of the numerous prehistoric Talayotic settlements found on the island, is another. There are seven lighthouses to be found here, Cavalleria, Favaritx and Artrutx, all worth a visit. And of course, not forgetting the S'Albufera des Grau nature reserve, the centrepiece of the island's UNESCO Biosphere Reserve status it was awarded in 1993.

Drawing from her extensive knowledge of Italy gained through living in Florence for a year and making multiple visits around the country over the past two decades, Travel Writer Nishi V shares her firsthand experience of planning a trip to Rome for the ultimate city break.

Rome is one of the most iconic cities in Europe. Every building breathes history in this impressive city and it can feel like you are walking through a huge museum.

However, Rome is such a popular destination, it feels as though everyone is there at the same time as you. Despite the crowds, there are plenty of ways to enjoy the city - and you won't be disappointed.

Before you pack your bags and prepare to eat your weight in gelato, here are my essential tips to make the best of your visit in Rome.

DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Dress respectfully. The Vatican and most churches have a modest dress code: no shorts, miniskirts or sleeveless tops. Pack appropriately to cover your shoulders and knees and save yourself from any lastminute panic purchases.

Wear comfortable shoes. I know this is really boring, but I guarantee your feet will thank you. Rome is a small city; all the landmarks are within relative walking distance of one another so your step count will inevitably rack up. If you do need to take a break from walking, Rome has a simple metro system which makes getting around even easier.

CHOOSE THE RIGHT SEASON TO VISIT

Spring and early autumn are the best time of year to visit Rome, where temperatures are mild and comfortable for walking around all day. If you choose to visit in the

summer, be warned - it's very hot and humid!

PLAN AN ITINERARY, BUT DON'T OVER PLAN

I'd recommend booking your trip and tickets to the main attractions in advance with your knowledgeable travel agent, as a good itinerary is essential in Rome. They'll make sure everything runs smoothly, and will be on hand should you need

them when you're away.

It's important to allow yourself some time to explore off the beaten path and soak up the atmosphere too. My advice would be to walk in the opposite direction to where the crowds are headed. People are so focused on their main goal, they may forget about the other things around them: the charming streets. wonderful architecture, secret alleys, piazzas

It's always worth considering paying extra for 'skip-the-line' tickets, as you might only have a few days in Rome and will probably want to see it all. Like me, you would probably rather not spend all your time queuing and completely miss out on a more authentic experience. BE AWARE OF **CLOSING DATES**

Don't assume everything is always open. The Vatican museums are generally closed on Sunday and most museums aren't open on Mondays, except for the Colosseum and Borghese Gallery which require pre-booking. Saying that, it gives you a chance to explore the city by foot and soak up the atmosphere.

ITALIAN MEAL TIMES

Italians usually head out for dinner

> from 8.30pm onwards, so you might find that some restaurants aren't open if you're accustomed to dining earlier. If you can't hold out until then, do as the Italians do and have an aperitivo from 7pm. Restaurant kitchens are known to close well after 10pm, so don't worry about missing out on a proper dinner!

> Don't miss trying gelato either; it's one of the delights people associate Italy with, and likely to be one of the first things you'll be searching for if you travel in hotter months. However, not all gelato is authentic; steer away from the gelaterias that display brightly coloured, puffy clouds of gelato. Real gelato

is made with fresh and natural ingredients, and a blended banana is never fluorescent yellow!

HOW TO GET THE BEST SHOT OF THE TREVI FOUNTAIN

To take great photos of the famous, must-see landmark without the crowds, arrive before 7am for the best photo opportunity, before everyone else has surfaced from their hotel rooms.

Alternatively, visit the United Colors of Benetton store across from the fountain and take a photo from the first-floor windows facing it. Obviously it won't be perfect... maybe the windows will be cleaner during your visit than they were during mine!
