

## Standing Committee Bursary Terms & Conditions

The Standing Committee Bursary will be offered for the first time in 2022 with the intention of funding a bursary for a resident of The Women's College.

The donation to The Women's College is an initiative as a result of funds raised from the annual Standing Committee Luncheon. The Bursary will be valued at \$4,500 and awarded annually (subject to sufficient funds being raised at The Standing Committee Luncheon in the previous year) from The Chislehurst Trust Fund.

The Terms and Conditions of the Bursary are as follows:

- 1. The name of the Bursary shall be 'The Standing Committee Bursary' and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College.
- 2. The Bursary shall be awarded to a current student of The Women's College during the tenure of the Bursary and who is enrolled at a university in Brisbane.
- 3. The Bursary shall be awarded to a resident who is from a low income and disadvantaged family who might not otherwise have access to The Women's College experience.
- 4. In awarding the Bursary, preference will be given to a student from rural or regional Queensland who is in financial need with respect to meeting accommodation expenses.
- 5. The recipient of the Bursary will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.
- 6. The Bursary shall be awarded for one academic year. The Bursary shall lapse upon the student ceasing to be in residence at the College.
- 7. The Bursary will be terminated if the recipient:
  - a) is no longer enrolled full-time at a university in Brisbane;
  - b) not maintaining satisfactory academic progress; or
  - c) is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
