World Food Safety Day 2022



Training on Medicinal Plants



One day training on "Medicinal plants and its utilization" was organized by the Department of Floriculture and Medicinal Crops, Horticultural College & Research Institute, Periyakulam on 08.06.2022. The role of commercial phytoherbs for primary health care and pharmaceutical utilization were the themes. Dr. J. Rajangam, Dean,

Rajagopal, Assistant Professor (Horticulture) emphasized on the hi-tech cultivation of aromatic plants and its utilization as well as the role of phytochemicals and bio-active molecules in herbal formulations. The IFFCO has introduced IFFCO Nano Urea which is first of its kind notified by FCO (Fertilizer Control Order) in 2021 in India vis-à-vis the



world. About 300 farmers from Erode, Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts participated in the event. On this eve, Dr. K.S. Subramanian, Professor and Head, Department of Nano Science and Technology, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore, welcomed the participants and offered preamble on IFFCO Nano Urea and its biosafety. 
First Aid and Emergency Call Training to NSS Volunteers
