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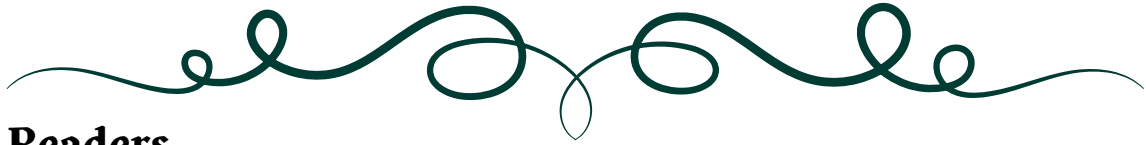

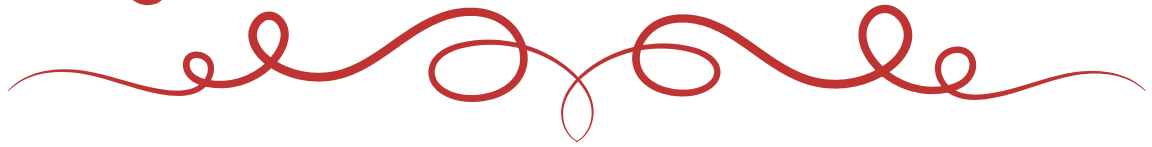

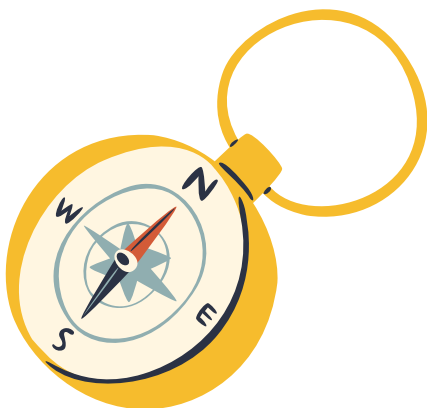

So dear students , keep enriching your learning by asking questions gravitated towards the subject and be an explorer .

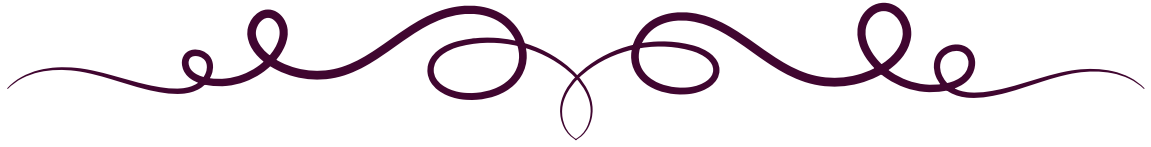

Yugal from grade 5 made a tree symbolizing qualities and emphasized that beauty resides in thoughts, deeds and within ourselves.



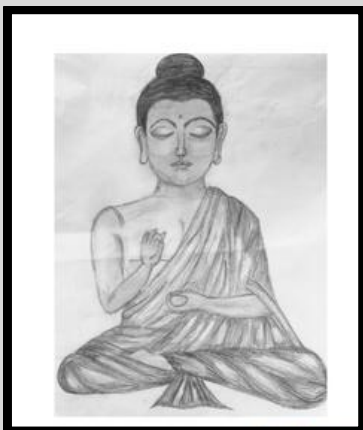

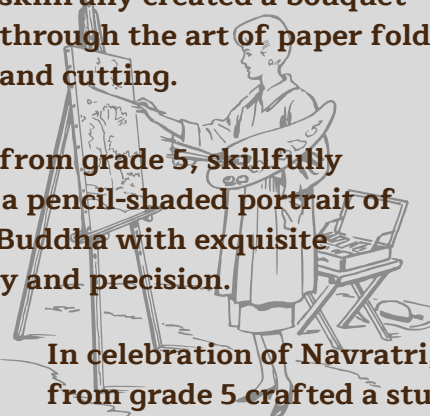

Aditi from grade 5, skillfully drew a pencil-shaded portrait of Lord Buddha with exquisite beauty and precision.



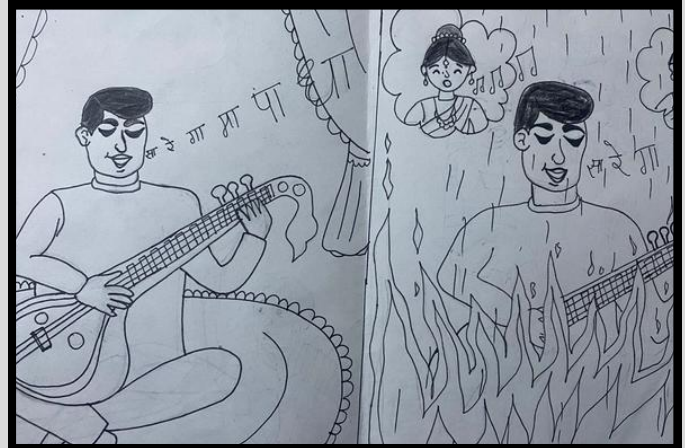

It fostered a sense of shared responsibility and environmental awareness among the students.



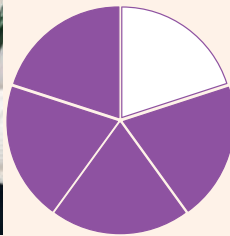


# MATHEMATICS IN NATURE
