Throughout 2021, our desire to lift the communities we serve has become even more prevalent, and our aspiration to work as an inclusive team also continues to grow.

The youth and families we serve live in a unique, ever-evolving world. As a result of the pandemic, many are still navigating physically distanced environments. Accordingly, several of our Forever Young initiatives are working to serve immunocompromised children and those experiencing a heightened sense of fear and isolation. Our association with Red Barn Farms has further supported those struggling with mental health issues and anxiety through the creation of a Forever Young Zone on their campus. This donated space is also providing a home for Forever Young Institute, as well as an occasional meeting space for some of our family of charities and community partners. In addition, our 8 to 80 Zones provide the ability to open our gaming spaces, not only for tech training and competitions, but also as social distance learning hubs during off hours—providing tutorials and academic extended day classrooms.

This year, new growth opportunities for Forever Young Foundation developed organically as many HGGC portfolio companies were introduced to our work. As these companies took part in our HGGC Steve Young Classic events, many felt compelled to invite their partners and teams to join in collaborating with the FYF family of charities--their support has grown exponentially, leaving Barb and me very thankful. Peter Foy invited his team to make donations directed to support Sophie's Place locations nationally at the PCF owners meeting. Randy Jacops highlighted Forever Young Foundation's work at his Idera Summer Fest. Bryan Adams partnered with us and The Learning Journey, resulting in Integrity Marketing donating over 1,000 toys to the Dallas Children's Hospital, and Traeger supported our events through their team service projects, helping Wasatch Adaptive Sports clean and manicure their biking trails while serving lunch to the adaptive athletes. As we build and expand our commitments to the Forever Young Foundation family of charities, this support helps us punch above our weight as an organization.

Finally, to our *OG's*—you know who you are. We see you and are thankful for your expertise, volunteer efforts, and financial support. You have made Forever Young Foundation what it is today, and we continue to be so grateful to each of you as we work together to support children in need.



8 to 80 Zones are a collaboration between Steve Young (#8) and Jerry Rice (#80), which provide youth living in underserved communities the skills to pursue careers in technology, esports, gaming, and mass media.

8 to 80 Zones not only allow for artistic expression but also afford students the opportunity to gain training on industry-leading equipment and software in the areas of coding, graphic design, television, broadcasting, voice recording, and game development.





FOREVER YOUNG ZONES

Thousands of children continue to be impacted each year in Forever Young Zones throughout the United States and Ghana, Africa. Individually designed for specific community needs, every Zone carries the theme "Be Your Own Hero." Children need role models to pattern their lives after, but ultimately, we want to equip them with the ability and desire to go out and become their own heroes. Forever Young Zones are created to inspire young minds and motivate active lifestyles, whether they be playrooms in children's hospitals, athletic facilities, or technology spaces in youth community centers.

FOREVER YOUNG INITIATIVES

ENGAGE NOW AFRICA

Forever Young's charitable efforts in Africa are administered through the African NGO, Engage Now Africa. Created by Lynette and Bob Gay in 2002, Engage Now's purpose is to "heal, rescue, and lift" by empowering those living in the communities they serve. Engage Now Africa is committed to providing programs with sustainable self-help solutions, fighting poverty, illiteracy, and disease through the funding and building of schools, microcredit loans, and providing humanitarian assistance. Forever Young and Engage Now Africa are empowering Africans to address their challenges with sustainable solutions.





SOPHIE'S PLACE

Sophie's Place was established in loving memory of singer, songwriter, and friend, Sophie Barton. These dedicated spaces are music therapy rooms built in children's hospitals that treat young people suffering from pain, chronic illness, and serious injury. They provide an integrative medical approach to prescriptive medicine—assisting physical therapy through body movement, alleviating pain, and supporting cognitive health by rewiring the brain synapses. While most people know music has an extraordinary power to bring comfort and peace to the soul, recent clinical studies have proven that music therapy offers a new evidence-based, integrative medical approach in treating these young hospital patients. WELLNESS

Forever Young Foundation has an abiding belief that children and young adults deserve access to programs and resources that help them achieve physical, social, and emotional wellness. Our Wellness initiative is designed to bring together, amplify, and improve the accessibility of these remarkable resources for young people and their families.



NONPROFIT INSTITUTE

Forever Young Foundation partners with the Arbinger Institute, a leader in management training and team building, to provide a year-long training for nonprofit professionals. With a mission to inspire excellence in nonprofit leaders and to help build sustainable, efficient nonprofit organizations, this forum instructs participants in how to develop, implement, and update a one-year operating plan and a three-year long-range strategic business plan.

Participants discover how to hold themselves accountable to their contributors while keeping board members, staff, and volunteers focused on achieving results. Through underwriting from Forever Young Foundation, private donors, and corporations, this training is offered at minimal cost to leaders seeking to ensure the sustainability of their organizations for generations to come.

Since its inception in 2010, over a thousand nonprofit leaders have participated in the Institute. In 2021, we specifically trained 18 organizations and over 50 executives and board members. We also held a two-day Forever Young Family of Charities conference, which brought 16 FYF associated nonprofits together in a setting where we could share best practices, resources, and challenges as well as provide opportunities to network.




