Pension questions top callers' queries

What part of my pension or profit-sharing plan is taxable?

The portion of your pension or profit-sharing plan that you have directly contributed is called "contributory" and is tax free when it comes back as a distribution, said Steve Malocco of Tonneson & Co. in Wakefield.

The portion that your company put in is "non-contributable" and can be taxed by both the state and the federal government, he said.

Pensions from private companies are taxable in Massachusetts. Pensions from city, state and federal agencies are not taxable by the state, but are taxed by the federal government, Malocco said.

The pension entry appears in two parts on the front page of your 1040 form. One part is for total received. The other is for the total that's taxable, Malocco said.

What do I do if I get my pension before I'm of retirement age?

If you're under 59½ years of age, you must roll your pension over into an investment within 60 days or face a 10 percent excise tax, said Jim Bailey of Needel, Welch & Stone P.C. in Rockland.

Most people roll their pensions over into an individual retirement account, or IRA, he said.

Bill Sheridan, of W.R. Sheridan CPA in Boston, recommends that you do research on your pension as soon as you get it and before it's too late to roll it over.

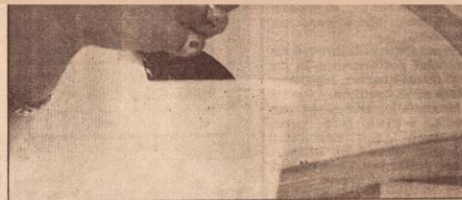
If you're over 59½, you can keep your pension and qualify for a lower tax rate if the pen-

sion is a one-time distribution, added Carol Tully of Wolf & Co. in Boston. The tax rate is usually treated as if it's spread out over five to 10 years, she said. What about early withdrawals of IRAs?

The penalty is the same for premature IRA withdrawals as for pensions, so roll the IRA over into another one, recommends Jim Bailey of Needel, Welch & Stone in Rockland. "The federal government

likes to see money put into savings," Bailey said. "It's best to do that because the earnings, while they're sitting there, are tax deferred.

Earnings from the IRA, but not the original principal, are taxable by the state, said Walter O'Panasetts of Shapiro Weiss & Co. in Boston. Be careful not to list your IRA principal on your Mass. tax return, he said.

If you know you must pay a penalty — but don't know how — you should call the IRS and they will send you a special form, said Barbara Taber of Alan Edelman & Co. in Boston. The form does not come with your regular tax forms.

Can I get a tax break if I sell my house or condo for a loss?

What if I sell for a profit?

You are allowed to deduct real estate losses only if they do not involve the real estate where you live, said Walter O'Panasetts of Shapiro, Weiss & Co. in Boston. Sales of principal residences are not deductible if you sell for a loss, O'Panasetts said.

If you sell for a profit, you will be taxed, but you can avoid it if you buy another home for the same amount or more than you sold your previous one for.

said Gary Demasek of Tofias Fleishman Shapiro & Co. in Cambridge.

Demasek said people over 55 years old qualify for a "once-in-a-lifetime" exemption of up to \$125,000 profit on the sale of their homes. But he warned them not to waste the exemption, especially if they are moving to a more expensive place. How do I pay a tax on a shared mortgage agreement?

Expensive housing prices are forcing more and more people to share their mortgages, but only one person gets the 1098 interest statement from the bank, said Burton Speer of Grant Thornton in Boston.

"There seems to be more people that — based on real estate prices in the last few years — have had to look for other means of financing," Speer said.

Family members, for example, will sometimes share mortgages, he said.

Speer said if you don't get the statement, then you must list your portion of the mortgage payment on your Schedule A form along with an attached statement carrying the name and address of the person to whom the bank statement is sent.
