THE CHALLENGE:

2 out of 3 individuals return to prison within 3 years without support.

Louisiana has one of the highest incarceration rates in the nation.

Formerly incarcerated people are 5x more likely to be unemployed.

OUR SOLUTION:



Cal-PRI provides returning citizens with:

- Employment pathways and job skills training
- Housing stability support
- Counseling, mentorship, and mental health resources
- Life skills development and community connections

HOUSING STABILITY IS ONE OF THE STRONGEST PREDICTORS OF SUCCESSFUL REENTRY.

One local man came to Cal-PRI after his release from prison with little hope and many barriers. Our team helped him through the expungement process, secured his driver's license, and connected him with the resources he needed to start fresh. With support, he was hired at a local refinery, and today he has a stable job, a home, and his own vehicle. Instead of returning to prison, he's building a future – for himself, his family, and his community.
