UNDERSTANDING FOSTER CARE

The Olympic Peninsula is a uniquely difficult place to be a kid in foster care. In more rural areas, foster care is deeply rooted, generational, and has serious long-term systemic effects. We live in communities with limited support services, high rates of poverty, and a critical lack of licensed foster homes.



Often, children are relocated hours off the Peninsula because of a lack of available homes.



60% of youth formerly in care fall below the poverty line, despite earning an income.



1 in 5 former foster youth will become homeless after age 18.



In Jefferson & Clallam
Counties, children are put
in foster care at FIVE times
the rate of King County.

IT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE THIS WAY

Our programs were built to change these outcomes.

Volunteers provide customized, meaningful support, which reduces caregiver stress and improves stability. We ensure that children, youth, and caregivers have tools, resources, and trusted community that they can count on. These relationships are transformational and have ripple effects that span generations.




HOW VOLUNTEERS ARE TRANSFORMING FOSTER CARE

Volunteers invested <u>6,811 hours</u> just this year! That's how you affect change. We are not a transactional organization—we are relational. Every interaction with our local foster care community is rooted in the goal of building authentic, lasting relationships.

Volunteers listen, bring meals, repair, help, move, tutor, clean, drop off groceries, budget, chauffeur, cheer on, babysit, and simply be WITH. These are just a few ways our volunteers continually go above and beyond, wrapping support around the youth and families they walk alongside.

Above all else, **volunteers give their time and love as they show up in the ways they are most needed.** Volunteers are the heartbeat of our programs, and we are so grateful for every one of them. **This is how we change foster care.** This is how we change the stats.



"WE'LL ALWAYS BE FRIENDS"



They waited for four years in the foster care system before they found legal permanency with their new family. But in late 2024, with their Olympic Angels volunteers with them in the courtroom, they were adopted by their foster mom.

The group of six volunteers fully stepped into this family's life in the most *meaningful* ways:

babysitting every Saturday so the caregiver got some time to herself or one-on-one with one of the kids, weekly **meal delivery**,

extra hands at events and around town, rides to daycare, and they went along with the caregiver and kids for visitations with their biological parents.

All along, the caregiver prepared for two outcomes - reunification with their biological parent or adopting them herself.

Their Olympic Angels volunteers were also ready for both scenarios, planning to either respectfully request to be invited into their lives once returned home or continue to be the current caregiver's support system through and after adoption.

Whichever outcome it was, these healthy, consistent grownups were **committed - to the kids,** caregiver, and their wellbeing. Through Olympic Angels, this family received stability, relational permanency, and made life-long friendships.





The Dare to Dream program matches mentors with youth to support them as they navigate life's celebrations and challenges. Mentors meet twice a month, addressing both practical and emotional needs while guiding youth through personalized developmental milestones.

IMPACT STORY CODING INTO ADULTHOOD



It's been a long journey for this youth.
In and out of care for most of his
life, facing significant physical,
mental, and academic challenges.

Missing large gaps of school through his foster care experience made graduation *unlikely*. However, over the course of the last year, his dedicated group of Olympic Angels volunteers worked closely with the school to develop a <u>success plan</u>.

Through his own hard work and a team of champions behind him, **he graduated!**

They turned him on to programming, and now he dreams of working at Microsoft one day (just like one of his most trusted Angels). He enrolled part-time in community college last fall and is thriving.

Now that he is in college, he has been matched with a *new* mentor - a former computer science professor. They met for the first time around the holidays and talked about their mutual interests in photography, walking, and coding.

Knowing that **only 3% of kids who experience foster care go on to college**, his mentor is <u>committed</u> to connecting this youth to his goal.


