We are really looking forward to meeting you on the Emsworth Arts Trail 2024 and sharing our new work with you.

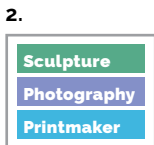
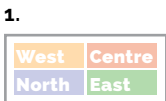

Travel information

Parking

In the centre of Emsworth, there are four pay-and-display car parks and some free on-street parking restricted to 45 minutes although these spaces tend to fill up quickly. There is plenty of free on-street parking just a short distance away from the centre and most of the venues away from the town centre also have plenty of free parking.

Buses

The 700 route has frequent services along the A259. Bus stops are shown in yellow on the maps.

Train

Southern Train services from Victoria to Portsmouth stop at Emsworth Station in the geographical centre of the Trail.

South Western services from Waterloo run to Havant where you can change for Emsworth or catch the 700 bus.
