Initial nosing revealed beef bourguignon, camphor, pineapple cubes and old-school boiled fruit sweets. We also got tonka beans, cinnamon sticks and sweet beef jerky. Some water enhanced these meaty vibes and brought out some further notes of wood varnish, cola cubes, orange zest and herbal extracts. The neat palate was robust and punchy. Up front, notes of grape must, fruit syrups, cinnamon and baking spices mingled with toasted fennel seeds, buttery popcorn and toffee sauce. Reduction made everything more relaxed and brought some lovely notes of orange pop, foamy fizzy drink crystals, cinnamon buns, rum fudge and milk chocolate ice cream.

Don't be fooled, this isn't "just another sherried 8", this one's a more lively, spritely, with some more dried spices in it, it's almost (would you believe it) like it fits perfectly into this new flavour profile of Dried Fruits & Spices. On sale June 5, midday AEST, for \$199 (discounted from \$219 just for June). Don't miss the limited Malt of the Month price!

WARMING WINTER SPICE

How cool that out of nowhere, Distillery 8 returned into our lives with a vengeance just a couple of years ago now. Think about it, it was the 8th Distillery to enter our portfolio way back in the early 80s, but this is only the 50th cask we've bottled from them in those 40+ years. Crazy to think about; to top it all off, they've all been these young, single-cask sherry-matured beasts with in-your-face ABVs and rich, meaty palates. 8.50 is no exception, just read the first tasting note "*beef bourguignon*" — damn!





DELIGHTFUL DEVELOPMENT

FRAGRANT & FLORAL

We were immediately impressed by the creamy, sweet fruitiness of the nose – impressions of banana split and strawberry yoghurt slowly sharpened to chocolate limes, plum jam, quince jelly and sherbet. The palate enjoyed good initial sweetness – crystallised honey, marzipan, vanilla cheesecake and candied orange dipped in chocolate, but the finish seemed spicier, with cinnamon apples, clove and coffee granules. Water brought out more astringent notes of lemon drops, perfumed pear and refreshers on the nose, then gooseberry fool, lemon zest, nutmeg and soor plooms on the palate – but all the while retaining the balancing sweetness of custard creams and brown sugar.

STROLLING THROUGH A BAZAAR

If you were a fan of Sweet, Fruity & Mellow bottlings, you should not overlook this one; candied pastries and sweets, zesty lollies, and a creamy palate. Cask 5.139 is truly a delightful development with a punchy 60.5% ABV and full maturation in a single 2nd fill ex-bourbon barrel. An example of this Lowland distillery like you've never known it — on sale June 5.





TROPICAL MESS

The Panel found the neat nose on this one rather juicy and full of jellied green and yellow fruits. We also noted exotic fruit teas, mango drizzled with honey and a luscious sense of texture. Water brought the green freshness of cut grass and gorse flower, plus lime curd, papaya and a wee vegetal hint of green pepper. The palate opened with a synchronous sense of juiciness alongside lots of sweet waxes, olive oil, coconut water and general syrupy fruit-salad goo vibes. Reduction maintained this lovely oily texture and weight, while adding in some cedar wood, vanilla cream, rosewater and fruity granola.

DEEP TROPICAL FRUIT IN A GLASS

There's something beguiling and deeply tropical about Cask 135.74. In our newer profile of Toasted Oak & Vanilla, this full-maturation in a 1st-fill ex-bourbon barrel, this is a bright dram that is equally at home on a warm afternoon as it is in the dead of winter. Truly a 'naked' example of this make perfectly matured for enjoyment. One to take on that winter hike with a loved one this winter.

The initial impression was of a highly fragrant and aromatically complex dram. It had lots of green fruit sherbet notes, with ripe orchard fruits, chocolate limes, candied citrus rinds and red cola bottle sweeties. We also registered some firmer hints of starched linens and putty. With water we agreed it was still highly expressive. Various notes of heather flowers, sandalwood, cut grass, barley water and mossy tree bark were all noted. The neat palate was richly malty at first, with clear spiciness, hessian and more putty, before displaying intriguing notes of salt and vinegar crisps, grassy rapeseed oil and muddled parsley. Water revealed a more generous sweetness, with lots of pineapple in syrup, bubblegum, orgeat syrup and hints of tropical fruits. This was matured in an ex-bourbon hogshead for nine years before being transferred to a second fill French oak Jamaican rum barrique.

TWO IN A ROW!

How lucky are we to get two bottlings from Distillery 60 back-to-back, that taste wildly different. Seriously, last month we saw an ex-PX American oak second maturation, and this month we're seeing ex-Jamaican rum (French oak) 2nd fill; not just a different flavour profile, but a completely different beast. Plenty of tropical fruit syrup, hessian, salt, and a bit of spice. The perfect blend of Spicy & Sweet and Spicy & Dry from the legacy flavour profiles.

The sweet fragrance of hibiscus tea, violets and sticky heather honey found perfect harmony with the citrus zing of spruce tips and whisps of smoke from burning lavender bushes. The floral notes serenaded prawns and lobster as they sizzled on a beach barbecue, while toasted brioche buns patiently awaited their arrival. With a little water, delightful textures appeared as miso paste, butter and salted caramel blended into fig ice cream. Now, the soft leather of vintage car seats sang a chorus in unison with cured ham, lamb chops and dried seaweed. The grand finale delivered an exotic ballad that brought together baba ganoush, tahini and lavender sumac on grilled aubergines.



A RARE PEATED TREAT

Six bottles — that's all there is of this discontinued livery release. 33 full years of maturation in a refill bourbon hogshead delivers the aged Islay giant that we all know and love, but with that cask-strength twist that doesn't allow flavour sacrifice. From our now vintage Vaults Collection line, this is one of the last bottles we'll see come through, so don't miss out on this truly limited bottling. Additionally, this bottling took out the top 'Masters' award at The Spirit Business Global Luxury Masters competition, their most prestigious accolade. Will you be one of the lucky six in the country to own and enjoy this 33-year-old, highly awarded Islay treat?

The nose had tropical paradise beach bar vibes – pineapple, melon, peach and citrus fruits, beautifully complicated by ginger, cinnamon, coconut and mint – it was DIY cocktail time! The palate encompassed sweetness (coconut buns, shortbread, vanilla sponge and honey), the sharpness of lime juice and sherbet fountains, and a wee subtle spice kick from humbugs and black pepper oatcakes. The reduced nose kept the fruit of pear belle hélène and limoncello but discovered more wood – sandalwood, cedar, bookcases and coriander seeds. The delightful palate delivered brown sugar, golden syrup and custard sweetness, balancing the warmth of spiced fruit cake.

A sweet, fresh and floral aroma of daisies, honeysuckle and lily of the valley greeted the Panel. Given a little time, the scent of a creamy homemade vanilla custard mingling with fresh herbs and white pepper appeared. On the palate there was plenty of fizz to start, with sparkling apple juice and bitter lemon preceding tropical cinnamon-dusted mangoes and, again, that white peppery note in the finish. Following reduction we sat at a table, with a fresh flower bouquet arranged in a glass vase as the centrepiece, to enjoy rhubarb crumble, buttered toast and honey-vanilla brioche rolls with a side of sweet 'n' salty popcorn.

THE CLEVER TASTE OF WAREHOUSE WITCHCRAFT

The neat nose was aromatically diverse, suggesting peppermint tea, tangy dark fruit chutney, balsamic reduction, herbal toothpaste and treacle tart. Some lovely, well-integrated sherry cask influence was also on display. With water it developed a lovely, broad honey-and-fruit combination, with impressions of fruit salad juices, pineapple rings, jasmine flowers and orange cocktail bitters. The neat palate presented us with notes of young bual madeira, camphor, brown seed bread, Dundee cake and export-strength Irish stout. We also found a surprising meaty zing of roast beef and horseradish. This was matured in a second fill barrel for 10 years before being transferred to a second fill, Spanish oak, oloroso hogshead.



A DRAM FOR PARTY ANIMALS

An ex-bourbon hogshead did some fine work for 13 years before this first fill port barrique took over. The nose indicated wild celebrations involving strawberry wine, kir royale and rosé champagne, with new shoes, sugared almonds, and jam and coconut sponge cake. The palate gave us craft cola, dried cranberries and sugar-coated fennel seeds plus tantalising flourishes of tobacco, old roses and chocolates filled with cherry liqueur. In reduction, the nose found sugar cane, red liquorice, bubblegum and dragon fruit. The palate was velvety and jammy with luscious red-fruit character, then slightly savoury on the finish – serving up honey-roast parsnips and prosciutto.

A SOJOURN IN SEVILLE

A warm street in Seville – orange blossoms falling, butter pastries, café solo and flamenco dancers' leather boots – that's the vibe we got from the nose. The palate was full-bodied, with dry oak and leather, crème brûlée and nutmeg on rice pudding, dried dates, figs, raisins and roasted nuts. The reduced nose gave sugared almonds, orange zest, dark chocolate, rum-soaked raisins and dusty floorboards. On the palate, we discovered runny caramel, polvorónes and chocolate, coconut and soft marshmallow snowballs; then a dry, warming finish of cumin, clove and cinnamon. After 13 years in ex-bourbon wood, we moved this into a first fill American oak oloroso hogshead.

The Panel awoke on an old Scottish island ferry, with coal soot cascading over salted raisin purée, toffee sauce and lapsang souchong tea. The palate was nutty and coastal, like dipping fried seaweed in olive oil and balsamic glaze, with sweet notes of marshmallow and ginger snaps to follow. Water introduced clove, honey, orange peel and charred lavender to the nose. The finish took us back to the bridge of the ferry, with a coastal salinity on the palate being accented by wintergreen mint and creosote. After nine years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, we transferred this to a first fill American oak oloroso hogshead for the remainder of its maturation.

Opening a chest of drawers, we found monkey nuts soaking in sweet red wine, bran flakes swimming in treacle-infused buttermilk and chocolate-coated fig jelly. The palate was an opulent steak and chewing tobacco pairing, with rosemary on French polished oak, fruit salad and liquorice. Water gave the nose a vintage oloroso, with luxury nuts from a festive hamper and Turkish delight drizzled with orange oil. The palate ended with crema catalana, dark chocolate and crumble topping.

"A breath of fresh sea air filled the nose, and the scent of creels, crab apples and wicker picnic baskets evoked a day's excursion along shell-strewn beaches. A seafood platter of mussels and rollmops was unpacked on deck in the salty breeze. The palate was oily, briny and complex, layering honey-smoked ham, tart candied fruits and peppered mackerel with wasabi peas and a whisper of coal dust, like a niçoise salad served aboard a Clyde puffer. With water, hibiscus jam washed over mussel shells and samphire, while the palate turned sweet and herbal, delivering dill pickles, charred lemon salmon pastrami and a medicinal finish of plum and old-school cough syrup on burnt toast. After spending 12 years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, this was transferred to a first fill Pedro Ximénez-seasoned barrique for the remainder of its maturation.
