Driven by a shared mission, we strive to strengthen infection control practices, advance antimicrobial stewardship, and cultivate local expertise in infectious diseases.





The National Infectious Diseases Conference 2021 was held virtually on September 25–26, bringing together healthcare professionals and experts to discuss the latest developments in COVID-19 management, vaccination efforts, and public health strategies. Organized by the Ministry of Health Malaysia and MylCID, the online platform enabled wide participation and knowledge sharing during the pandemic.











The Tropical Infectious Diseases Conference 2023 (TIDC 2023) was held on 13–14 March at The Everly Hotel in Putrajaya. The event provided an important platform for healthcare professionals and researchers to share insights on recent advances in tropical infectious diseases affecting the region. Highlights included sessions on the dengue burden amidst climate change, advances in dengue diagnostics and management, difficult-to-treat tuberculosis, drug-resistant typhoid, complicated malaria, and updates on COVID-19 management.







The **MyAMR Conference 2024** has become a flagship national event focused on combating antimicrobial resistance (AMR) in Malaysia.

Bringing together clinicians, microbiologists, pharmacists, IPC practitioners, researchers, and policymakers, this conference provided a vital platform for knowledge exchange, collaboration, and strategic action against the national and global threat of AMR.


