



MY ENCOUNTER WITH THE LORD

On the other hand, I now all of a sudden had a boss at my domestic job who would always tell me, "Lunge, you are not cut for this job", Time and time again, she would even mention how it made her feel uncomfortable having me do her domestic work. One day, my boss's lady told me to prepare my CV. She told me that she had put in a one-month resignation notice; her position was advertised in the newspaper, but her boss was just not finding a suitable candidate. She told me that her one-month notice was almost coming to an end, but her replacement had not been found, and she was a bit worried. So she told me to prepare my CV, so she takes it along and just puts it amongst those coming in.

I went back home, went to a nearby Internet café shop, prepared a quick CV, printed a copy, and handed it over to my boss lady the following day. She took it along to work, and surprisingly, around 10 a.m. that same day, I received a call for an interview for a job at Philtronics CC that I had applied for. For a moment I was blank; I almost said I didn't apply for any job, then suddenly I remembered that it was probably from my boss's company. The interview was scheduled for the same day at noon. I did my chores, later locked the house, and proceeded to my interview.

Upon entry at the company, the first eyes I met were those of my boss lady at reception, who indicated to me to shhhh and pretend I didn't know her. I greeted her and informed her I was there for an interview. She stood up and led me through to her boss's office, who was the manager of the company. I entered the office all nervous, but the manager just greeted me and asked me a few personal questions. We chatted for a few minutes, and towards the end she asked, "When can you start? You've got the job!" I could not believe my ears. I responded, "As soon as possible." And she said, "How about tomorrow?" I said, "Yes, ma'am, tomorrow is fine." I went back to work to complete my chores and to make sure I finished all the ironing. And then I sat and waited for my boss lady to inform her of the outcome of the interview. She was already informed, and she was quite happy that I got the iob. She and her husband wished me well.

The following day I started work as a receptionist at Philtronics CC, which was an IT company and the only authorized IT company in Namibia back then to service and refurbish HP computers and printers. It was a small company; the structure was: manager, finance person, receptionist, three technicians, and a cleaner. The receptionist was also like secretary to the manaaer, organizing the diary and logistics. This paid N\$3500. It was a good payback then.


Now that both my husband and I had a better income, we moved to a bigger house. At the beginning of the following year, 2008, we brought both our kids to the capital city to live with us so we could stay as a family. The first-born daughter was enrolled in Grade 1, and the second-born boy was in preschool. After two years of marriage, we sought to have a third child, but I just couldn't fall pregnant. I tried for 2 years. And after several attempts to fall pregnant, I decided to go for a pap smear. The results of the pap smear indicated that I had precancerous cell growth in the mouth of my womb and had to undergo an operation.

I went for an operation, and the cells were successfully removed. However, the doctor's report said it would be hard for me to get pregnant. I was heartbroken. I could not understand why it suddenly seemed impossible when I needed a child. **Ouestioned God. But** in my crying, I still prayed to God to make a way. And after a year, I fell pregnant and gave birth to a healthy boy, whom I named Miracle. And again in 2019, God blessed us with a beautiful baby girl. The story continues in the next edition.



3. Integrity



May the Spirit of the Lord be upon you this week so that you may be able to discern the perfect will of God for your life . Prosper in Jesus's name .



Nia-Cerise Conteh answered this call, as she has always yearned for women to no longer be hidden in the shadows. Instead, they should rise up and take the position assigned to God. Her mission is to impart the knowledge and skills required to empower them on their journeys through her ministry.

Naftalie Shigwedha Amukwelele, born January 1, 1974, commonly known as D-Naff, is a Namibian multiple award-winning and top-selling rapper, singer, actor, and former street gangster. D-Naff sings inspirational gospel and religious music in the styles of kwaito, rap, kizomba, dancehall, and afro-pop. D-Naff is also a motivational and inspirational speaker and has visited more than 100 schools, universities, and colleges in Namibia, including the Namibia University of Science and Technology, formerly the Polytechnic of Namibia, Windhoek College of Education, Ongwediva College of Education, and the University of Namibia. D-Naff is married to Dainess Ziba, originally from Chingola, Zambia, who is popularly known as Lady Dyna. She is also an artist under D-Naff Entertainment, and she is a Namibian multiple award-winning gospel artist as well. The couple has two beautiful kids: a girl, Princess Ethana Amukwelele, and a boy, Prince Ethan Amukwelele.

D-Naff's music career started back in the early 90s while he was a student at "Jan Jonker Afrikaner Secondary School" in Windhoek. He was part of an acappella group called the "Glamour Boys," whose members were all part of the National Youth Choir of Namibia. Later on,went on to establish yet another group called "Eagle's Mentality," which became the winner of the 2005 "Best Gospel" at the Sanlam-NBC Music Awards. Today, D-Naff is ranked as the 15th most downloaded artist on iTunes in Africa and second in Namibia after King Tee Dee.This gospel legend in the land of the brave today has a total of more than 12 albums that he started producing in 2006. He released his first solo album, entitled Oshagwana, in 2006, which made him more popular. In 2007, he released his second album, entitled likele Yuuyuni Mbu, which won him an award at the Namibian Music Awards in the gospel category with his song.






His music has seen him collaborate with international artists such as Marvin B3 Kasomo, Mark B3 Kasomo, Prince Keddy, Ephraim Mutalange, Ty2, Damiano, Chola Chola, and Tio, both from Zambia.In 2017, he collaborated with award-winning Zimbabwean-born gospel artist Magacha on the single 'Ndinotenda Jesu'. D-Naff admits that as soon as he heard Magacha's music, he immediately liked it and decided on a music collaboration. That same year, D-Naff also worked with Zambian musician Ty2. The two had worked on three songs previously, and D-Naff wanted to work on another with him.Over the years, D-Naff has held gospel concerts right across Namibia, and these concerts usually draw large crowds.

The artist also owns his own record label, D-Naff Entertainment. His work has been exceptional, as he keeps getting awarded locally and beyond. Here are some of the awards that D-Naff has got over the years. D-Naff has been appointed as the (goodwill) ambassador for the National Youth Council of Namibia (NYC).In 2014, he was appointed Kora Awards Goodwill Ambassador 2014/2015 to Namibia in the fight against the Ebola virus, joining 53 other African artists and musicians who are also Kora Awards Ambassadors in their respective nations. Together, they raise awareness about the Ebola virus and also raise funds to be sent to the organizations dealing with the epidemic. In 2019, along with other artists in the country, there was a bid to raise awareness about gender-based violence. MTC launched the Gender-Based Violence Knockout Boxing Project, which saw the who's who battling it out in the boxing ring to raise awareness about violence against women and children.

Make a vow. Walk down the aisle. Put a ring on it. To choose Him and spend your life with him. Make it forever!





This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. -<u>1 John 5:14</u>

Prayer should always be our first approach to any problem. Before we set out to face our inner demons, it helps to take a moment and return our hearts to God. Scripture tells us that the Lord hears our prayers and will walk with us through any trial (Psalm 102:17), so we shouldn't worry about standing alone. God knows our fears, he knows our suffering, and he loves us through it all. That knowledge alone can be very encouraging.

So take a moment and present your troubles to God. Tell him about your anger, your sadness, and your fear. Don't be ashamed, because he wants hear your worries. Who knows? By the end, you may discover your burden has grown a little lighter.

2. Journal

On that night the king could not sleep. And he gave orders to bring the book of memorable deeds, the chronicles, and they were read before the king. - <u>Esther 6:1</u>

Putting pen to paper can often help liberate your inner feelings. Don't worry about grammar or neatness, simply sit down and write. Some Christians may find it cathartic to write about their anxieties, while others gain encouragement by reliving old adventures. Either way, the act of journaling can serve to nourish and satisfy the mind. Studies have even found it's especially helpful for those suffering from stress-induced insomnia.

Oddly enough, even Biblical characters were fond of journaling. When King Xerxes couldn't sleep, he had a servant read to him from the recorded histories. David and Solomon were both experienced poets, and would frequently put their emotions into verse (Psalm 13:2). You don't have to create the next American classic, just take a moment and put your thoughts to paper.

3. Lean on Your Community

"Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ." - <u>Galatians 6:2-12</u>

Never be embarrassed to share your struggles with other Christians. The Church was created so that fellow believers could nurture, protect, and inspire one another as they pursued Christ. In recent years though, too many congregations have become obsessed with outward appearances. They put on a showy display of being happy, wholesome individuals when inside they're barely holding together. This type of thinking is neither healthy nor holy.

If you're feeling overwhelmed, it's ok to reach out to your community for help. Find someone within the congregation whom you trust and let them know what's happening. No Christian was meant to go through life alone. So instead of toughing it out, lean on your fellow believers and remember we're all strongest when we work together.

4. Eat Well

"Do not join those who drink too much wine or gorge themselves on meat, for drunkards and gluttons become poor, and drowsiness clothes them in rags." <u>Proverbs 23:20-21</u>

PThis may sound strange, but what you eat can have a profound effect on how you think! The <u>Bible</u> has plenty of warnings against <u>gluttony</u>, and its words are practical advice for anyone wrestling with their mental health. When we overindulge in sugary drinks or deep-friend foods, we're more likely to become overweight, incur physical problems like diabetes and heart disease, and see a drop in our overall self-esteem. Tempting as it may be to sooth our troubles with comfort food, Christians must learn to practice self-control.

Instead of snacking on candy, why not try a bowl of fresh fruit? Incorporate leafy-green vegetables into your diet, and cook up a nice piece of fish for dinner rather than a greasy burger. It may not seem as appetizing now, but you'll be amazed at how much better you feel in the long run.

5. Read Your Bible

"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." - <u>John 16:33</u>

This one should be a no-brainer. Scripture is filled with multiple, encouraging passages for anyone going through a rough period. For starters, it helps to know several Biblical figures also struggled with depression and anxiety. Job was so miserable he cursed the day of his birth (Job 3:1). A dejected Elijah actually went into the wilderness and begged God to kill him (1 Kings 19:4). Even Jesus knew how it felt to suffer mental anguish (Luke 22:44). If you're feeling depressed, just know you're in good company.

Thankfully, the message doesn't stop there. The Bible teaches us that God will give us strength (Isaiah 40:31), provide shelter (Nahum 1:7), and walk with us through these dark times (Psalm 23:4). 
