Learner is onboarded to the learning platform and receives an introductory email from the department, Adult Handbook and introductory email from tutor/assessor.

Learners are supported throughout the course until they complete all units of work and these are signed off by both the assessor and moderator. Support may include onsite or Microsoft Teams meetings with the Learner Engagement Lead, Platform Lead, Tutor or Lead IQA. Learners can come in to use the Learning Centre, Bursary Support, extensions and additional time. Assessors provide additional information on how they can expand their knowledge by providing links to additional reading and relevant sources to develop industry specific knowledge. They have feedback assessment points for every question within the unit and summative feedback at the end of each assessment. Learners are provided the opportunity to complete feedback forms to ensure they have been provided with everything they need for the course and identify any areas of strength and areas for perceived improvement. Individual learner progress is monitored weekly during our Caseload Review meeting.
