Volunteer Ambassador brings mission to life

Like every parent, Cheryl Hanks has always wanted the best for her daughter, Renee, who was born with a developmental disability. That's why when she learned about AbleLight's programs to help people learn skills to foster independence, Renee came into our care.

"It's been a wonderful place for so many years," explained Cheryl.

That was 25 years ago, and today, Cheryl, who was a single mother of three children, knows she made the right decision. A partner like AbleLight gave her the opportunity to have all her loved ones blossom with the focus and attention they deserved to grow. This was especially true during COVID-19, because individuals with disabilities are at a higher risk for infection and disease. This group also had higher social isolation rates and saw a decrease in social and physical activity, which are contributing factors to their independence and ability to flourish. Cheryl credits the Magnolia House team in Minnesota with keeping her daughter safe, engaged, and feeling supported.

"That made me say I have to do more," Cheryl said. "Praise the Lord, she's alive and thriving – that's why I got involved."

Last year, Cheryl became an AbleLight Ambassador. She began hosting *Mission Moments*, social gatherings that share AbleLight's Christian mission and invite others to get involved with our community. People learn about the vital roles of direct support professionals (DSPs) and volunteers in our homes. They also hear how they can welcome people with disabilities into their homes.

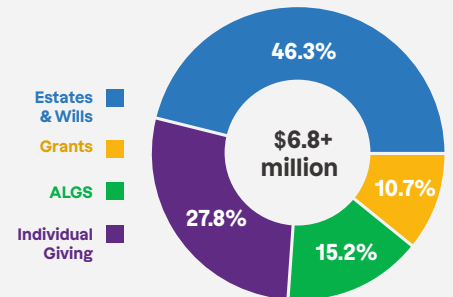

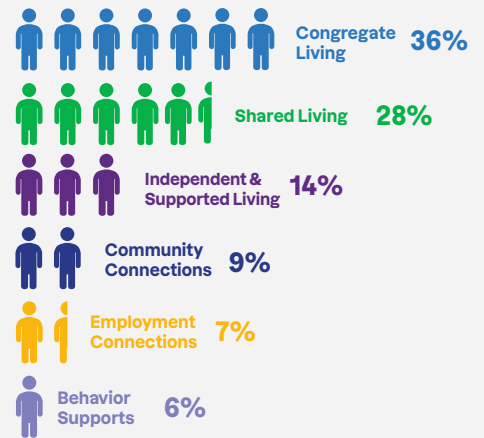
Your Impact

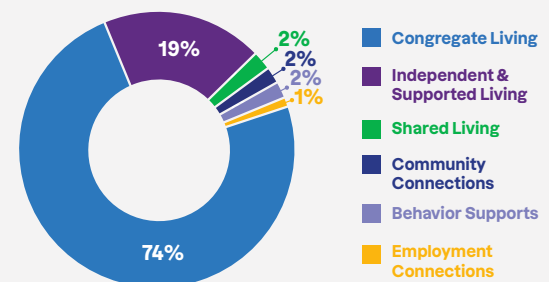
Total Donations (as of 8/31/2023)

DSPs meeting our greatest needs

As a child, Tyler didn't meet milestones and couldn't recognize his own name. School proved difficult, and soon, Tyler was diagnosed with autism. His mother was told he would never read and certainly never graduate high school.

Yet his mother didn't give up. Years of occupational therapy and social skills classes followed. "He has a standard high school diploma even though they told me he was never going to graduate," she said.



"Having a job is amazing – just absolutely amazing," said Tyler.

After school, Tyler set his sights on getting a job. But he faced barriers many of us don't and looked for employment for over a year with no success. Sadly, his sense of rejection grew. But then he received a life-changing phone call from AbleLight.

Today, Tyler is a direct support professional, or DSP with AbleLight, doing what others did for him! Tyler is a caring and compassionate worker who bonds closely with the people in his care. This role supports people in a home environment, and right now, filling DSP openings is our greatest need.

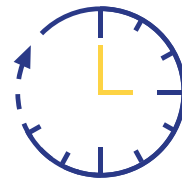

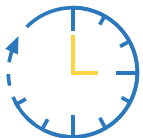
