/// Business Administration and Customer Service Industries

Whether you are looking for work, or you want to re-train to improve your employment prospects this **free course** can help you develop the skills you need to work in a business administration role.

You will gain an understanding of the role of a business administrator as well as learning about important policies and procedures governing the sector and the importance of health and safety.



In addition, you will also improve your digital and IT skills, develop key employability skills - such as communication, teamwork and problem solving - and get help with producing a CV, applying for jobs and preparing for an interview.

/// Essential Digital Skills

Whether you are a beginner and need to learn the basics of IT, have some computer knowledge and are keen to develop more, or want to become an expert in using digital devices, these **free courses** will improve your confidence in using a range of IT software packages.


