






To Meet Academic Needs

Reader's advisory services


Ask the librarian to provide recommendations if you're unsure what to read




The librarian creates book lists and bibliographies with reading recommendations

Book talks and tastings can be arranged with classroom teachers



To Meet Social-Emotional & Creative Needs
