

many countries bottle and label the oil in their own country, implying that it is local. One of the biggest culprits of this is Italy.

3. MOST OLIVE OIL IS PRODUCED IN THE PROVINCE OF JAEN

As you travel through Jaen all you see are endless olive groves covering the entire landscape. The climate is perfect for growing olive trees and olive oil production is centred in the province. In fact, about 70% of all Spanish olive oil comes from Jaen.

4. SPAIN IS THE 2ND LARGEST OLIVE OIL CONSUMER IN THE WORLD

Despite Spain producing so much olive oil, Greece consumes more on an annual basis. The average consumption in Spain is approximately 10 litres per year.

5. THE OLIVE TREE WAS INTRODUCED TO SPAIN ALMOST 3000 YEARS AGO

The Phoenicians brought the olive tree to Spain in around 1050 BC. The Romans then distributed olive groves throughout Spain and the Moors brought more advanced cultivation methods.

6. GREEKS AND ROMANS REFERRED TO OLIVE OIL AS 'LIOUID GOLD'

Olive Oil was extremely valuable in both Ancient Greece and the Roman Empire, hence the reference 'liquid



gold', and they used it for cooking and as fuel. It is also thought that it was used to light the earliest Olympic torch.

7. SPAIN HAS OVER TWO HUNDRED VARIETIES OF OLIVES

Of the large number of varieties, only about 25 are used for oil, each with its own unique flavour and aroma.

8. THE AVERAGE LIFESPAN IF AN OLIVE TREE IS BETWEEN 300-600 YEARS.

Spain is home to some of the oldest olive trees in the world. Tarragona's Museo del Arión displays a tree that is said to be over 2,000 years old.



OLIVE OIL IS A JUICE

Technically olive oil is a fruit juice! It is crushed like other fruits; oranges, lemons etc.

EACH OLIVE TREE GIVES 4 LITRES OF OIL YEARLY

One olive tree can produce around 30 kilos of fruit which is approximately 4 litres of oil every year

9. SPAIN IS HOME TO 300 MILLION OLIVE TREES.

That is almost the same as the population of the entire USA!

10. OLIVE OIL CAN BE USED FOR FRYING.

Although we are often told that olive oil burns, many varieties of olive oil are ideal for frying Cooking with olive oil is considered the healthy option and some studies have shown that frying vegetables in extra virgin olive oil can actually be healthier than boiling them.

REMOVAL OF WEALTH TAX



Wealth tax in Andalucía (Marbella) to be removed

he president of the Junta, Juanma Moreno, said the abolition will attract investment to the region, and he also announced a reduction in the rate of income tax and the cancellation of the water tax in 2023.

ONE OF FEWEST TAXES

Andalucía is about to become the region of Spain (with the exception of the Basque Country) with the fewest taxes after Madrid, the president of the Junta, Juanma Moreno, announced this Monday morning. From Wednesday 21 September there will no longer be a wealth tax in Andalucía.

POSTITIVE IMPACT

Moreno said this tax accounts for 0.6% of income for the regional government (95 million euros a year) and the change will have a very positive impact on increasing revenue and attracting investment.

Ten of the top 20 wealth tax

payers in 2019 left Andalucía in 2020, resulting in a loss of income of nearly 18 million euros (3.5 million euros in wealth tax and 14 million euros in personal income tax).

The president of the regional government has said he wants people with high income who spend long periods in Andalucía to make it their permanent home and pay tax there. "This will help us to develop economic activity and employment," he said.

PERSONAL INCOME TAX

With regard to personal income tax, Andalucía will reduce this by 4.3% "above the amount that the government says salaries will rise by". This will leave 125 million euros in the bank accounts of Andalusian residents, Moreno explained at a forum organised by Grupo Joly in Madrid.

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



f there is an image that characterises summer, it is that of the beach. The overcrowding of umbrellas, sand castles and portable refrigerators full of food and drink to survive a hot day on the sand are what many of us remember most about summers in Spain.

QUALITY

Spain is considered privileged when it comes to the general quality of its beaches. This is reflected in the large number of blue flags it is awarded each year (621 in 2022) which are only given when stringent environmental, educational, safety, and



accessibility criteria are met and maintained. Beach lovers in Spain can enjoy nearly 8,000 kilometres of coastline lapped by the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean, making it difficult to choose which beach to spend the day at.

For this reason, National Geographic has shared its selection of the very best beaches in Spain, among which three are located on the Andalusian coast.

This unusual feature is in fact the ruins of the old Torre de la Higuera guard tower,

which fell after the Lisbon tsunami of 1755





Spain's most expensive place to buy and rent property



ased on recent research from the property portal Idealista, Benahavis continues to be the most expensive place to buy or rent property in Spain.

GATED COMMUNITIES


Benahavis is not surprisingly ranked in first position considering it has some of the most prestigious and exclusive urbanisations and gated communities in Spain, including the infamous La Zagaleta where senior company executives, celebrities, sporting stars and multimillionaires all own homes.

Property prices here are well above everywhere else in Spain with average property prices of over €1.8 million and average monthly rents of around €4,000.

LA ZAGALETA

La Zagalata consists of over 250 homes built on plots of between 3,000 and 10,000 m2, together with two 18 hole golf courses.

La Zagaleta's villas occupy a 900-hectare estate between mountains and valleys, but with views of the Mediterranean. Construction began on the urbanisation in the early 1990s thanks to a group of investors led by Enrique Pérez Flores. The land had first belonged to the family of a well-known pharmaceutical businessman. It then passed into the hands



of arms dealer Adnan Khashoggi. In 1989, the banks seized the estate of the Saudi tycoon to pay for his debts. It was then that Pérez Flores set his sights on the land to build his urban project and transform La Zagaleta into what it is today.

EXCLUSIVITY

The hallmarks of La Zagaleta are now privacy, exclusivity and security. The exclusive complex is located just ten minutes away from Marbella and has access to two lush golf courses, elegant clubhouses and an equestrian centre.

HOW DO OTHER LOCAL AREAS COMPARE?

In total, nine municipalities in Malaga were ranked in the top 50 most expensive places to buy, including Marbella in third place with an average property price of €1.1 million and Estepona where the average price is €490.000.
