




Powers of neurodiversity



THE PLANETS LIKE ONE BIG FAMILY



The Solar System consists of the Sun, eight planets, dwarf planets, moons, asteroids, and comets, all bound by gravity to the Sun. Earth is the only known planet with life. The system is located in a spiral arm of the Milky Way galaxy, and it formed about 4.6 billion years ago.

Components of the Solar System

- The Sun:A massive star that makes up most of the solar system's mass and provides light and heat.
- Eight Planets: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars (inner, rocky planets), and Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune (outer, giant planets).
- Dwarf Planets:Officially recognized dwarf planets include Pluto, Ceres, Eris, Makemake, and Haumea.
- Moons: Hundreds of moons orbit planets, dwarf planets, and even some asteroids.
- · Asteroids and Comets: These are smaller celestial bodies, with comets being icy remnants from the solar system's early days.
- The Kuiper Belt and Oort Cloud: Regions at the outer edges of the solar system containing numerous icy bodies and comets.

Key Characteristics

- Age:The Solar System is approximately 4.6 billion years old.
- Galactic Home: It is located in the Milky Way galaxy, specifically in a partial arm called the Orion Arm or Spur.
- Formation: The system formed from the gravitational collapse of a large molecular cloud.
- Gravity:The force of gravity keeps all celestial bodies, from planets to comets, orbiting the Sun.

Unique Features


- Jupiter's Great Red Spot: A massive, persistent storm larger than Earth.
- Venus's Rotation: It has a day longer than its year and rotates clockwise.
- Mars's Volcanoes: Mars is home to the Solar System's tallest volcano, Olympus Mons.
- Uranus's Tilt: This planet rotates on its side, appearing to roll along its orbit.



Dunes

Dunes are mounds or ridges formed by the wind blowing or waves depositing sand. They form various shapes like crescentric, star, dome or parabolic dunes being commonly seen.

Sand dunes are always shifting shapes as the wind carries more sand. A process called



saltation takes place which is a process where a fluid like water or wind moves loose particles or grains like sand across a surface.











THE MACHINE THAT TURNS CARBON DIOXIDE INTO FUEL



Researchers at the University of Cambridge have developed a breakthrough method to capture carbon dioxide from the air and convert it into syngas, a clean fuel. By harnessing natural sunlight, the process creates a carbon-neutral energy cycle—removing CO₂ from the atmosphere and transforming it into usable solar fuels. While the technology shows great promise, further work is needed before it can be made widely available.

The benefits

Since the Industrial Revolution, the amount of carbon dioxide in the air has grown much higher than expected. This machine helps lower CO₂ levels while producing useful solar fuel. If it becomes widely available, people could see carbon dioxide as a renewable resource, helping to greatly reduce global warming. It would also give countries a cleaner alternative to fossil fuels, cutting pollution and protecting the environment. Over time, this kind of technology could change the way we think about energy and create a more sustainable future for everyone.

On Tuesday, 23 September 2025, the final results were revealed: Ousmane Dembélé claimed the top honor, finishing more than 300 points ahead of his closest rival, Lamine Yamal. Liverpool's star winger Mohamed Salah also shone with an outstanding season, securing fourth place in the rankings with 657 points.

The Kopa Trophy, awarded to the best player under 21, went to the sensational Lamine Yamal, while the prestigious Yashin Trophy for best goalkeeper was claimed by Gianluigi Donnarumma.


INTRODUCTION

HISTORY

TSMC, or Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company, is a Taiwanese computer chip manufacturing that holds a complete monopoly on advanced computer chips. It is in the top 10 most valuable companies in the world, yet it is rarely discussed or heard of. This is because it never directly interacts with human customers, instead its clients are massive electronics corporations like Apple and Nvidia. Since to 1990s it has been the leading company in the world of semiconductor manufacturing, so its value comes as no surprise given the influence of chip-powered devices in our modern world.

TSMC started as a project by the Taiwanese government to build its semiconductor industry in 1986. Startup capital was provided by the government, wealthy Taiwanese families, and Phillips. Phillips played a crucial role in the initial stage of TSMC, giving it semiconductor manufacturing technology, intellectual property, and patents to TSMC. Chip designers were struggling with manufacturing because it began to get very complicated, so TSMC solved that by specializing the chip manufacturing process. Since its founding it has gradually but surely become one of the most valuable companies in the world, almost monopolizing the advanced chip making industry.

TSMC is the 8th most valuable company in the world thanks to the huge socioeconomic significance of computer chips. Every tablet, phone, computer, graphics card, or other high-level processors (with the exception of some Samsung and Intel devices that use other foundries). It is a crucial part of global supply chains, considering the significance of computer chips. TSMC specializes in manufacturing chips, contrary to Samsung and Intel, which both design and manufacture their chips. There are pros and cons to this. Pros include accessibility (manufacturing chips is incredibly difficult especially given the complexity of modern chips), and specialization (TSMC has an economy of scale given its size which can lead to better pricing).

Cons of TSMC's specialisation business model include lack of customization (while Intel and Samsung can customise their manaufactring process to the unique features of their products, clients of TSMC do not get much leverage because TSMC manages manufacturing).

Apple is TSMC's largest customer, accounting for a quarter of its revenue, Other major customers include NVIDIA, the most valuable company in the world thanks to the recent AI boom which is relying on NVIDIA chips, and communications technology companies like Quallcomm and Broadcom which make the technology needed for Wi-Fi and connections to the internet.

INTRODUCTION

HISTORY

ASML, or Advanced Semiconductor Materials Lithography is the sole global supplier of Extreme Ultraviolet (EUV) lithography machines, a cutting-edge technology vital for manufacturing the most advanced chips used in smartphones, laptops, and other electronic devices. Beyond EUV systems, ASML also provides Deep Ultraviolet (DUV) lithography machines, metrology and inspection systems, software, and extensive customer support services.

ASML, originally founded in 1984 as a joint venture between Dutch companies ASM and Philips, became an independent publicly traded company in 1988. It gained significant market presence with the 1991 release of its PAS 5500 lithography system, widely adopted by major clients like Micron Technology. Over the years, ASML advanced its technology by collaborating with global partners and acquiring companies such as Silicon Valley Group in 2000 and Cymer in 2012 to enhance its lithography systems, especially in extreme ultraviolet (EUV) technology. By 2002, ASML had become the largest supplier of photolithography systems. Despite setbacks such as the 2008 sales drop and intellectual property theft incidents, the company rebounded and continued to innovate, expanding its influence in the semiconductor manufacturing industry.
