## MAKE YOUR MENTAL HEALTH - A PRIORITY






# The First Day of A New School







# BEAUTIFUL MIND, BETTER THAN A FAIR COMPLEXION





हालांकि हिंदी की स्थिति मजबूत है, फिर भी इसे कुछ चुनौतियों का सामना करना पड़ रहा है। अंग्रेजी का बढ़ता प्रभाव, खासकर शहरी क्षेत्रों में, हिंदी के विकास के लिए एक चुनौती है। इसके अलावा, कई क्षेत्रीय भाषाओं के साथ प्रतिस्पर्धा भी हिंदी के प्रसार में बाधा बन सकती है। कुल मिलाकर, हिंदी की वर्तमान स्थिति उत्साहजनक है, लेकिन इसे बनाए रखने और आगे बढ़ाने के लिए सतत प्रयासों की आवश्यकता है। हिंदी भाषा की समृद्धि और सांस्कृतिक महत्व को बनाए रखने के लिए इसे सभी क्षेत्रों में प्रोत्साहित किया जाना चाहिए।

भाषाई कौशल की अभिवृद्धि भावी पीढ़ी को सशक्त बनाती है जिसके परिमार्जन और पल्लवन की जिम्मेदारी पाठकों की होती है। हिंदी के प्रति उनकी संवेदना साहित्यिक और सांस्कृतिक चेतना की संवाहिका है जिसे सदैव जीवंत रखने की जरूरत है।

## शिक्षा प्रणाली

ब्रिटिश कब्जे के बाद प्राचीन शिक्षा आधुनिक शिक्षा की ओर मुड़ गई जो ज्यादातर सीखने के दृष्टिकोण पर केंद्रित है। इतना विकसित होने के बावजूद भी भारतीय शिक्षा प्रणाली में उतनी प्रगति नहीं हो पाई है। इसने इतने सारे प्रतिभाशाली दिमाग पैदा किए हैं जो भारत को पूरी दुनिया में गौरवान्वित कर रहे हैं, लेकिन, यह सबसे पुरानी प्रणालियों में से एक है, यह दूसरों की तुलना में ज्यादा विकसित नहीं हुई है, जो वास्तव में नए हैं।

कहा जाता है कि विदेशों में शिक्षा प्रणाली काफी हल्की और व्यावहारिक ज्ञान पर आधारित है जबिक भारत में सैद्धांतिक ज्ञान और अंक प्राप्त करने पर जोर दिया जाता है। विद्यार्थियों से अपेक्षा की जाती है कि वे अवधारणा को समझने के बजाय एक के बाद एक अध्याय पढ़ें और कक्षा में अच्छे अंक प्राप्त करें। भारतीय स्कूलों में अंकन प्रणाली प्राथमिक कक्षाओं से शुरू होती है जिससे छोटे बच्चों पर बोझ पड़ता है। प्रतिस्पर्धा दिन-ब-दिन बढ़ती जा रही है। माता-पिता चाहते हैं कि उनके बच्चे अपने साथियों से बेहतर प्रदर्शन करें। इसीलिए भारत की शिक्षा प्रणाली को अनुपयुक्त एवं पुरानी कहा जाता है।

एनईपी 2023 ने पारंपरिक 10+2 पाठ्यक्रम को 5+3+3+4 संरचना में बदल दिया। आलोचनात्मक सोच, समस्या-समाधान, व्यावहारिक कौशल पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने और बच्चों को आधुनिक दुनिया के लिए तैयार करने के लिए पाठ्यक्रम को भी अद्यतन किया जा रहा है। शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण, शिक्षकों को शिक्षण के नए विचारों पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने और कक्षाओं में प्रौद्योगिकी का उपयोग करने में मदद करता है।
