OVERVIEW

Santiam Christian began in the Fall of 1979, with 55 students in grades 9-11 at New Life Center in Albany Oregon.



BACKGROUND

In 1980, SC moved to the Adair Village campus we occupy today. Fundraisers back in the day consisted of Newspaper drives, catching chickens, food booths, and the county fair.

In the summer of 1984, over 2,400 volumes were catalogued for our library as the state of Oregon evaluated accreditation for Santiam Christian Schools. All the hard work paid off, and SC was accredited by ACSI in the spring of 1985.

On November 14, 1985 Santiam petitioned the U.S. government for 12 buildings and 16.5 acres for the price of \$1.00. On February 28, 1989, SC officially obtained ownership of the parcel of land.

SC continued to grow, and merged with Heritage school on July 1, 1990. At this point, the student body was 310 students and it became apparent that we would need more space. God provided for us then, and has continued to provide for us again and again throughout our history. We have been blessed to have a continually growing campus that now includes Elementary, Junior High, and High School buildings, 2 playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, fine arts, music, and theater facilities, science, woodshop, agriculture, and culinary labs, greenhouses, and more.

We are honored to participate in welcoming international exchange students into our halls, and delight in getting to know them, and learning from them while they are here. Hundreds of our students have participated in 30+ missions trips from China, to the Dominican Republic, to Ukraine.

OUR SCHOOLS

Preschool * Elementary * Junior High * High School

At Santiam Christian Schools we believe that no student should have to leave personal potential at the doors of a Christian school. That's why our dedicated, certified staff works every day to ensure we deliver academic programs that integrate Biblical worldview with rigor and excellence. From the pre-schooler learning "Handwriting without Tears" to the senior studying AP Calculus, all students are taught with one goal in mind – to help them achieve their full potential in Christ.

PRESCHOOL AGES 3&4

Preschool is a readiness program encouraging mental, physical, social and spiritual development. The class focus is on a readiness for kindergarten in all activities.

Our mission is to develop young children with active and creative minds, a sense of understanding and compassion for others, and encourage their spiritual faith. We stress the total development of each child's spiritual, moral, intellectual, social, emotional, and physical values.



ELEMENTARY

Santiam Christian Elementary combines a warm, caring environment with Christian educators dedicated to helping each child succeed. Our teachers gently guide student learning through focused instruction informed by brain-based research. The core academic classes in Reading, Language, Math, Science, History, and Bible provide a quality foundation. Class sizes offer opportunities for one-on-one instruction and allow teachers to build lasting relationships with each student.

Enrichment classes offer students a wide variety of hands-on activities and experiences. Science Lab allows students to perform science experiments, while music classes allow students to sing, create music, and move to the beat. 4th graders learn to play the ukulele, while 5th- and 6th-graders have the option of choir or band. Computer Labs, Art, and PE classes let students explore and learn while having fun.

SC Elementary provides a quality Godcentered character education. Giving our students the foundation to succeed academically, socially and spiritually as they grow and mature throughout their childhood.





JUNIOR HIGH

Santiam Christian Junior High offers the best of both worlds – strong academics balanced and delivered by caring, Christian educators, right when your student is making the transition from elementary school to high school. SC junior high teachers understand these transition years are all part of God's plan in helping your student grow into the man or woman they will one day become.

From Discovery electives designed for students to explore their God-given talents to the core academic classes of Science, English, Math, Social Studies, and Bible, students have the opportunity to mature and progress in a safe and caring environment. Our Junior High is large enough to offer quality programs, yet small enough that individuals don't get lost in the transition. Your student will always be more than just a number at Santiam Christian Junior High!

At the Junior High level (7-8) it is our goal to provide a daily integration of the spiritual and academic areas. God and the Truth of His Word are viewed as foundational to all further investigation and study.

HIGH SCHOOL

Building on the foundations laid in the elementary and junior high programs, Santiam Christian High School provides a strong, sure academic foundation for our young adult graduates. Whether pursuing a college education, a place in the workforce, or service to country through a military option, SC coursework and community life equip our students for the next step!

With outstanding faculty and curriculum in every class, excellent core academics, and a generous number of electives to choose from, students at SC are well-prepared for whatever option they choose after high school. Best of all, they are not only equipped with the knowledge and skills they need to succeed at the next level, but also provided with the opportunity to develop a foundation in wisdom and worldview that will serve them well throughout their adult lives.

From the freshman level through AP options, classes, and the community at SC, the approach to student learning emphasizes both the acquisition of knowledge and skills and the wisdom and ability to use that understanding well. Biblical principles and intentional character development are woven throughout the academic program and student life activities at SC. Students are challenged to invest well, learn much, pursue excellence, and live together with respect, compassion, and encouragement for all.

High academic and citizenship standards at SC encourage each student to be good stewards of his or her heart, mind, and whole person, so that we can honor God and live effective lives for Him and for His kingdom.
