HISTORY OF THE NIAA

The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) is recognized as the governing body of high school athletics in Nevada by the State Legislature. It is noteworthy that the NIAA does not receive direct state funding, and its revenue streams are derived from corporate partnerships, event ticket sales, and member schools' dues.

Originally established in 1922, the Nevada Interscholastic League (NIL) became affiliated with the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) in 1939. The League was formed by school administrators to enforce standardized rules for high school sports.

In 1967, the NIL evolved into the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association. The appointment of the first full-time salaried Executive Director occurred in 1974, and an office was subsequently established in Carson City. The NIAA office then relocated to Reno in 1997 and further to its current location in Sparks in 2018. Notably, the NIAA has had six full-time Executive Directors, including Bert Cooper (July 1974 – June 1989), Dr. Jerry Hughes (July 1989 – December 2006), Eddie Bonine (January 2007 – February 2015), Bart Thompson (July 2015 – 2021), Donnie Nelson (2021 – 2024), and Timothy Jackson (2024 – present).

The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association is incorporated in accordance with NRS 81.170-81.280 and was recognized in 1974 under the provisions of NRS 385B.010-.190. The NIAA's Handbook, encompassing rules and regulations, is outlined in chapter 385B of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The NIAA holds responsibilities for sanctioning athletics, organizing post-season tournaments, regulating officials, certifying coaches, and providing various services to its member schools, including health and welfare standards.

As of August 2024, the NIAA comprised 124 member schools, categorized into five classifications.

The NIAA is responsible for a wide range of activities including recognizing academic team champions in

each NIAA-sanctioned sport and honoring individuals on the All-State Academic Team. Additionally, the organization hosts a Hall of Fame Banquet and induction ceremony to celebrate outstanding student-athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, and contributors who have made a significant and positive impact on Nevada's youth. The NIAA also certifies coaches and contest officials, promotes a cooperative spirit among member schools through its Citizenship Through Sports program, publishes informational materials, oversees committees, endorses the Drug, Alcohol, and Tobacco policy, and works to prevent the exploitation of student-athletes by special interest groups.

ORGANIZATION

Legislative Commission

The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) aims to promote, coordinate, and regulate interscholastic activities to enhance the educational experience of secondary school students in the state. The NIAA's policy-making authority lies with the Legislative Commission, comprising the superintendents of the 17 county school districts in Nevada, with the exception of Esmeralda County, which does not have a high school.

Board of Control

The NIAA is governed by a 12-member Board of Control, with representatives from the state's administrative regions. These representatives are elected by the county boards of school trustees within their respective regions. Additionally, non-voting liaisons from various school classifications and associations, including student representatives, serve on the Board of Control. The Board convenes regular quarterly meetings to oversee the affairs of the NIAA and elects a president and vice-president for a two-year term during its winter or spring meeting in odd-numbered years. Meetings are timely communicated to member schools and the public.

Member Schools

Member schools are organized into classifications and regions/leagues to facilitate scheduling and interscholastic competitions.
