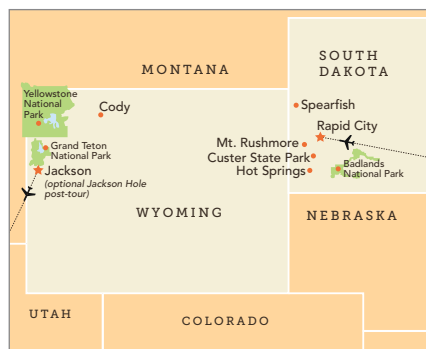

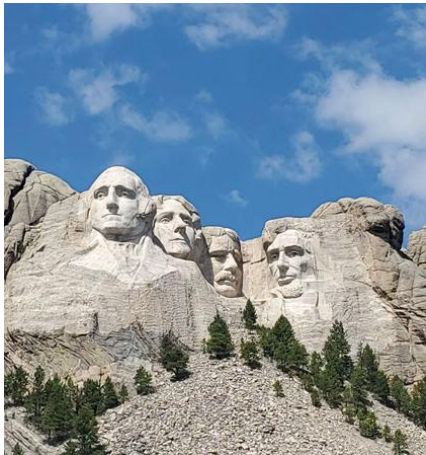

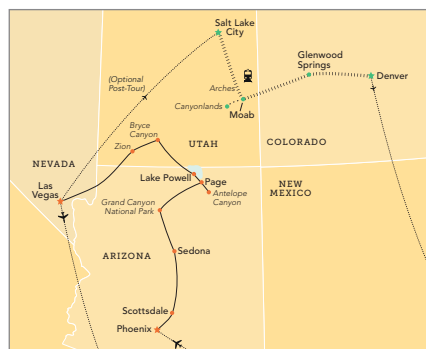

Wolves & Wildlife of Yellowstone

JANUARY 2026 (call for available dates)

Polar Bears & Beluga Whales

JULY | AUGUST 2026
