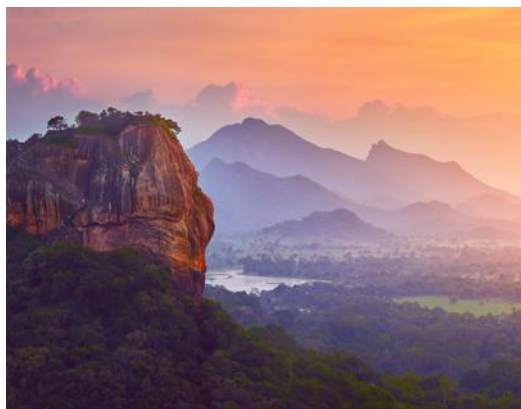
SRI LANKA

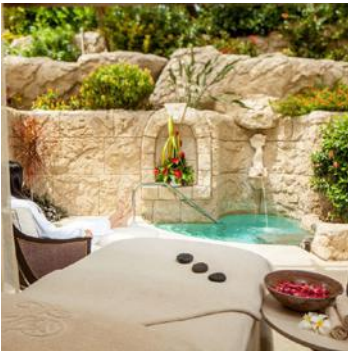
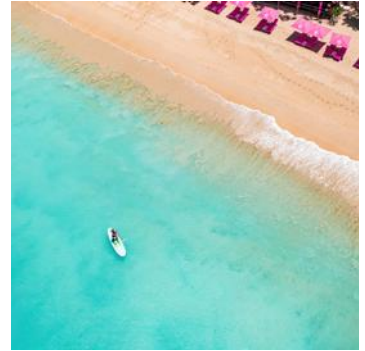
SANDY LANE BARBADOS

THE BAHAMAS





As the nights draw closer and the weather turns colder, cast your imagination to swaying palms, spiced rum punch, startlingly blue waters and powdery soft sand - the Bahamas ticks all the boxes for your dreamy Caribbean fantasy.

This intricate archipelago of islands features 700 islands and cays, with only 30 of them inhabited. There are underwater spectacles, vivid mangrove forests, talcum-fine beaches and intriguing culture to explore. Adventurous types can swim with sharks or dive to underwater wrecks, while those with a quieter disposition may want to soak up the sun with a cocktail in hand, or stroll around colourful arts and crafts markets.

It's common to pick the dry season for travel which is in the winter with warm days and cooler evenings. In December, expect highs of around 25°C – 27°C, perfect for chilling on the beach or snorkelling offshore.

Popular places to visit include Nassau (see page 8-9), brimming with history and heritage and home to gorgeous beaches including Cable Beach. It's next to Paradise Island which is where you'll find the famous Atlantis resort among others. From the UK, you'll usually fly straight into Lynden Pindling International Airport, right by Nassau, so it's worth spending some time in the city before heading further afield.

Other places to visit include Andros, the largest island in the Bahamas. It's popular with divers and hikers for its unspoiled ecosystem and natural wonders like blue holes and coral reef. There's also some world-class deep sea and fly fishing here as well as 1.5 million acres of tidal flats and mangrove creeks you can explore by kayak.

Harbour Island is famous for its pink sand beach, elegant atmosphere and colourful clapboard houses. The shallow waters invite you in for kayaking and paddleboarding, and it's a great place to begin exploring the islands and cays by boat. There are more underwater wrecks here than any other place in the Bahamas, so get ready for an adventure beneath the waves.

The list could go on. Pods of dolphins, flamboyant parades, high-octane waterparks, swimming pigs, awe-inspiring national parks... you'll discover it all in the Bahamas.

GRENADA

Grenada, the 'Spice Isle of The Caribbean', is a feast for the senses – where the scent of nutmeg drifts through the air, the water glows every shade of blue, and adventure waits beyond every palm-fringed bay. With its calm seas and golden sands, Grand Anse Beach is the island's star – a two-mile stretch perfect for swimming, paddleboarding, or simply soaking up the Caribbean sun.

Out on the water, Grenada's famous Underwater Sculpture Park offers a surreal diving or snorkelling experience, it's an art gallery beneath the waves where coral and sea life have claimed hauntingly beautiful statues. On land, explore the colourful streets of St George's, the capital that curls around a horseshoe-shaped harbour, its pastel buildings and market stalls buzzing with local life and spice-scented air.

From waterfall hikes in the lush rainforest to sunset sails along the coast, Grenada is pure sensory indulgence – a place where every experience feels as warm and vivid as the island itself.





BEQUIA BEACH HOTEL BEQUIA, ST VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES
