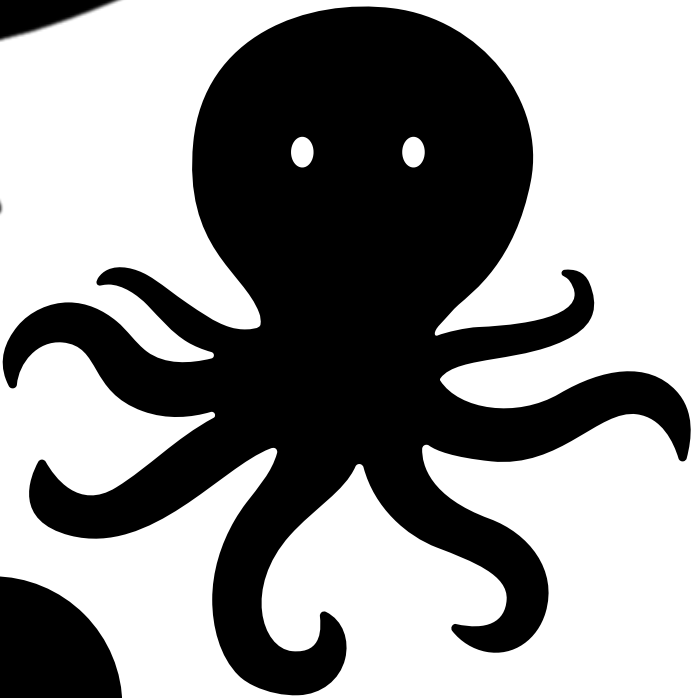


Sharky the Shark and the Treasure Chest
