CHURCH ROOF

On four of the hottest days in August, the church roof guttering was completed. A T Cornfield did an excellent job and everything went as smoothly as it could. Phase 1 of the roof repairs is completed and now onto phase 2...the thatch roof!

THATCH UPDATE

We had the welcome news from Congregational and General Trust of a grant of £9,200 towards the costs of the thatch. We're waiting to hear from two more grant bodies with a further two applications to be submitted. With donations received from the community and through the giving at baptism, wedding and funeral services, we've £24,000 still to raise. It's meant, sadly, the thatch couldn't be replaced this year. Natural England have given the Church Council permission to do the work in April 2025. We're hoping and praying the money comes in to ensure this can happen.

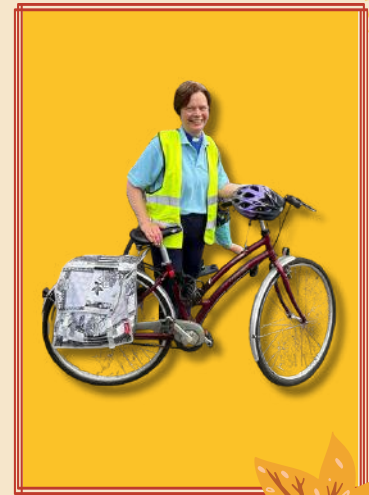

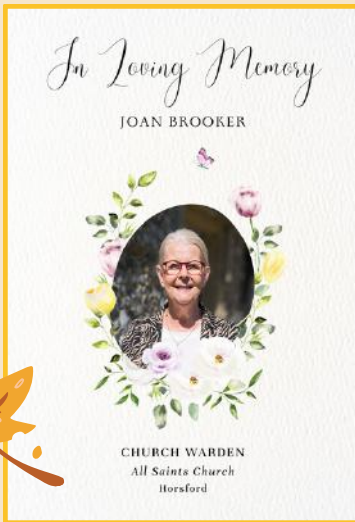
