
> OCTOBER 07' 2022 - GROUND RULE ACTIVITY IN BALLARI CENTER

Exxon Mobil under their CSR wanted to get RO plants installed in villages to help with safe drinking water. Unnati executed these projects across 2 places in the first phase. Each RO plant provides safe drinking water to over 1000 people in the village. The recurring cost and running of the plant are managed by the Panchayat by charging Rs.5/- per can of 20 litres from the user. The plants are being used extensively today by the villagers. It is indeed a WOW moment for all of us and we thank Exxon Mobil for this initiative.
