THE RISE, FALL, and Rebirth of Kramer Guitars An Iconic Journey Through Guitar History

Kramer Guitars has carved a unique and enduring legacy in the annals of guitar history. Founded in the late 1970s by Dennis Berardi and Gary Kramer, alongside other key figures like Peter LaPlaca and investor Henry Vaccaro, Kramer initially set out to revolutionize the guitar world with their innovative aluminum-necked guitars. This journey, marked by innovation, partnerships, and a battle through financial difficulties, encapsulates the transformative era of rock music and guitar craftsmanship.

Aluminum Meets Wood

Kramer's inception was greatly influenced by Gary Kramer's association with Travis Bean, a pioneer of aluminum guitar necks. Unlike Bean, Kramer aimed to modify the concept by integrating wooden inserts into aluminum necks, which helped in reducing the weight and improving the feel of the guitars. Introduced in 1976, Kramer guitars featured what became known as "Alumi-necks," an innovative design incorporating aluminum reinforced with pitchfork-like inserts of walnut or maple. These guitars, equipped with Ebonol fretboards and high-quality Schaller and DiMarzio hardware, set new standards in guitar design.

Transitioning to Wooden Necks and Global Manufacturing

By 1981, Kramer began transitioning to wooden necks, a strategic move aimed at reducing costs and appealing to more traditional guitarists. This period also saw the introduction of the iconic "beak" headstock and the start of offshore production in Eastern Asia. The company's forward-thinking approach was evident as they embraced global manufacturing, setting the stage for a significant evolution in their product offerings.

Partnership with Eddie Van Halen and Dominance in the 1980s

Kramer's partnership with Eddie Van Halen marked a pivotal moment in the company's history. This collaboration, initiated by a chance encounter between Dennis Berardi and Van Halen's manager, led to the introduction of the Rockinger tremolo system and later the more advanced Floyd Rose® tremolos. By the mid-1980s, Kramer was not only innovating but also leading the market, becoming the top-selling guitar brand in 1985 thanks to these high-performance features.

Challenges and Decline

Despite their success, the late 1980s brought significant challenges for Kramer. Financial strains, exacerbated by a massive labor strike in Korea in 1987, artist endorsement deals, and royalty payments to Floyd Rose began to take a toll. The company's financial overextension led to a notorious firesale of parts and ultimately to bankruptcy by 1991.


Acquisition by Gibson and Modern Era

After several tumultuous years, the Kramer brand was acquired out of bankruptcy by Gibson Guitar Corporation in 1997. This acquisition marked a new chapter for Kramer, which now benefits from Gibson's extensive resources while continuing to honor its legacy through reissues of classic models and limited runs.

TODAY, Kramer remains a respected name in the guitar world, celebrated for its contributions to the development of the electric guitar. The brand's journey from innovative startup to industry leader, followed by its rebirth, offers a compelling chapter in the history of modern music.

Through all its ups and downs, Kramer has truly lived up to its late 1980s slogan, "A Step Ahead," by continually evolving and influencing the music industry's approach to guitar manufacturing.





PREPARATION IS THE KEY TO A SUCCESSFUL DJ SET.

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Correction and Retraction

Firstly, let's set the record straight. This was not a staged technical failure, as some early reports and viewer impressions had suggested. We've received definitive information from the technical teams involved, confirming that the issue was user error, not a fault with rekordbox/CDJ reliability. Case closed.

User Error vs. Technical Reliability

It's crucial to highlight that this incident underscores the importance of user familiarity and expertise with their equipment. Given the widespread use of rekordbox/CDJ technology and the attention this story has garnered, it's significant to clarify that the design of rekordbox may have made this type of user error more likely.

There's an underlying frustration when big-name artists with huge budgets fail to deliver on their performance. The issue of authenticity has been a longstanding debate in the music industry, with comparisons even drawn to the downfall of Milli Vanilli.

The Importance of Preparation: Insights from Elster Pieterse

Elster Pieterse from the DJ and Music Production Institute weighs in on how to avoid such mishaps. At our DJ school, the first two lessons focus on understanding rekordbox and working on playlists that include hot cues. We believe in not letting students touch the gear until they've mastered rekordbox's functionality and have a set ready to go.

Crafting the Perfect Set

Whether you're playing on a big or small stage, preparation is key. Rekordbox is an excellent tool for organizing tracks in an order that matches key, BPM, or the mood you're aiming for.

Tips for Crafting Your Set

Storytelling through Music: Notice how your favorite DJs transition from track to track, telling a story throughout their set.

- Consider Your Time Slot: Play music that suits the time and mood of your set. For example, an opening track like 'Nalin and Kane - Beachball' is a crowd-pleaser that sets a relaxed tone.
- BPM Matching: While playing tracks in key is beneficial, it's not always necessary. If the BPMs don't match, avoid pressing sync blindly. Manually adjust the BPM in rekordbox to ensure a smooth transition between tracks.

Preparation is the key to a successful DJ set. By understanding your equipment, crafting a well-thought-out playlist, and being mindful of your audience and time slot, you can avoid common pitfalls and deliver a memorable performance.







Proaudio Sound Press: What advice would you give to aspiring DJs and artists looking to make their mark in the music industry?



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In an engaging interview with Proaudio Sound Press, Aiden, also known as The Plugza, delves into his journey and experiences that sculpt his unique approach to techno music.

From his foundational days at The DJ and Music Production Institute in Sandton to the vibrant techno scenes he cultivates, Aiden's narrative is one of innovation and passionate pursuit of musical excellence.

Proaudio Sound Press: You honed your production skills at The DJ and Music Production Institute in Sandton. How has your training at the institute shaped your approach to music and contributed to your growth as an artist?

Aiden aka The Plugza: Training at the institute has shown me the broad spectrum of how I as an artist am able to express the ideas that are stuck in my head through my creativity and inventiveness. It only added to my passion for music as I saw how much effort is put into making music.

Proaudio Sound Press: The Sheds has become a significant movement in the music scene. Could you delve into what sets The Sheds apart from other venues, and what makes it such a special place for artists like yourself to perform?

Aiden aka The Plugza: First and foremost, the energy and the people are unmatched. In the Vaal, there are few to no places for me and other talented artists from the Vaal to showcase our talent. For us to drive 60+ km every weekend to experience good music is pretty challenging. So for us, we have to create our own space to allow our locals and others to explore our genres of music and overall have the best experience.

Proaudio Sound Press: Transitioning from a small town like The Vaal to the bustling music scene must have presented its own set of challenges. How did your upbringing in The Vaal influence your musical style, and what obstacles did you encounter while trying to establish yourself in the DJ scene?

Aiden aka The Plugza: I want to thank my family for influencing my style of music, they showed me that there are no limits to what music can do or sound like. The DJ scene has presented its challenges, I've learned that if you're going to do what everyone else does, you're not going to stand out as an artist or be seen. Stay in your own lane and find your own sound, stop worrying about what other people do and focus on yourself.

Proaudio Sound Press: As an artist who's deeply immersed in techno music, what draws you to the genre, and how do you express your unique artistic vision within the confines of techno's sonic landscape?

Aiden aka The Plugza: The underground scene is beautiful in its way, the people are what makes it special. A pounding kick drum against some interesting sound design connects with me like nothing else. In its own way, it sounds "expensive". I like to break the boundaries of the sonic landscape; there are no limits in creating techno.

Proaudio Sound Press: Your upcoming music release under a new alias sounds intriguing. Can you share any insights into the inspiration behind this new project and how it differs from your previous work as The Plug? What can fans expect from your upcoming releases under this alias?

Aiden aka The Plugza: I've been pondering about this, but I have to take risks. My new techno alias is "Luigi Giacomozzi", my releases will showcase who I am as a person and will tell you a story of how far I've come and how much I've learned in this industry. My inspiration comes from the mighty And Club and all the Collectives that host parties there. Each of them is unique and has shown me the different styles of techno and how you can be creative in that space, I wish to explore that.

Proaudio Sound Press: Electronic music is constantly evolving, with new sub-genres and styles emerging all the time. How do you stay ahead of the curve and continue to innovate within the ever-changing landscape of electronic music?

Aiden aka The Plugza: I think it's important to listen to all types of genres and subgenres. You can implement that in your music and make it your own, that's what I'm doing in my music as well.



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Proaudio Sound Press:

Collaborations are often an integral part of the music industry. Are there any artists or producers you dream of collaborating with in the future? What do you believe makes for a successful collaboration in electronic music?

Aiden aka The Plugza: I believe people with the same interests and intentions work well together. The interests should be making good music and having fun while doing it. I would love to collaborate with Cullen Enslin and Paws from Underground Africa; they are my favorite local artists and they push the boundaries of the genre techno.

Proaudio Sound Press: Techno music is known for its immersive and hypnotic qualities. Can you share a memorable experience from one of your performances where you felt a deep connection with the audience, and what role do you believe atmosphere plays in a techno set?

Aiden aka The Plugza: This was an easy one, the first launch of The Shed was so intimate, I felt so connected with everyone, especially because they were locals and friends that want change in The Vaal. I could feel everyone's energy behind the decks and I was playing from that.



Proaudio Sound Press: As a producer, you have a unique opportunity to shape the sonic landscape of your tracks. Could you walk us through your creative process when producing music, and how do you ensure that your tracks convey the emotions and energy you intend?

Aiden aka The Plugza: I always start with the drums, I strongly believe that Techno is all about the groove. I always try to do something new with my drums in all my tracks that I'm still wanting to release. It all depends on how I feel the day, but I always try to show up and give it my best shot while sitting behind the computer.

Proaudio Sound Press: Electronic music is often associated with visual artistry, such as captivating visuals and stage setups. How do you incorporate visual elements into your performances, and what do you hope audiences take away from the sensory experience of your shows?

Aiden aka The Plugza: The setup at The Shed is sensational with lots of visual lasers being portrayed on the ceiling of the venue. I want to make people feel as comfortable as possible and try to give them the ultimate "rave" experience. I want people to walk in and forget about what's going on in the outside world and lose themselves on the dance floors and in the music.

Aiden aka The Plugza continues to be a beacon of innovation and creativity in the South African techno scene.

His approach not only reshapes the boundaries of what techno can be but also deeply connects with those who experience his music, live or through recordings.

Tyla, Gunna, Skillibeng


Jump




Fisher Remixes
