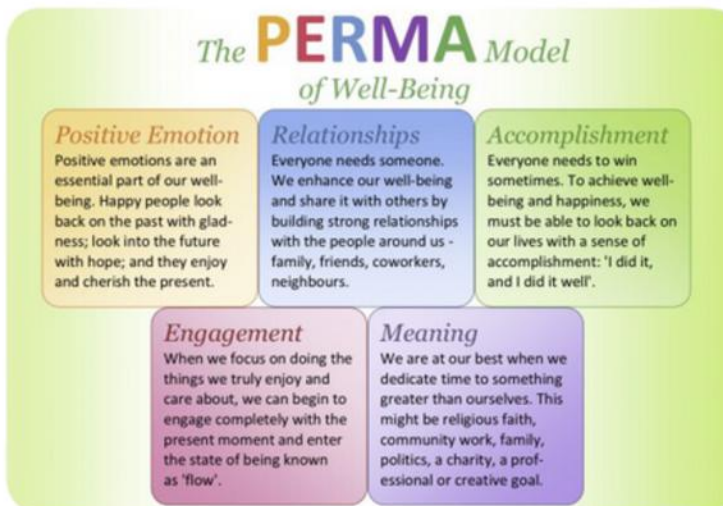

EXCERPT FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S SPEECH

Teman-teman, para guru, dan semua warga Indonesia yang saya hormati,

Hari ini, kita merayakan Hari Kemerdekaan Indonesia yang ke-79 dengan penuh semangat kebebasan dan persatuan. Tahun ini, tema kita adalah "Nusantara Baru, Indonesia Maju," yang mengajak kita untuk melihat ke depan, memasuki era baru yang lebih baik dan maju. Ini adalah saat yang tepat untuk berani berubah dan bersama-sama mengangkat bangsa kita ke puncak yang lebih tinggi.

Dalam merayakan kemerdekaan ini, mari kita ingat bahwa kebebasan bukan hanya hak kita, tetapi juga tanggung jawab. Ini tentang bagaimana kita menggunakan kebebasan untuk membantu sesama dan memastikan semua orang memiliki kesempatan berkembang. Ini sejalan dengan "Profil Pelajar Pancasila"—nilai-nilai yang ingin kita tumbuhkan dalam diri siswa-siswi kita. Berikut beberapa contoh kecil yang bisa dilakukan siswa untuk mewujudkan nilai-nilai ini:

- Keimanan dan Ketakwaan: Ayo kita buat kelompok belajar untuk diskusi moral dan spiritual, agar kita bisa lebih memahami keyakinan kita dan menghormati keyakinan orang lain. Dengan ini, kita bisa membangun identitas moral yang kuat dan mengedepankan kejujuran dalam kehidupan sehari-hari.
- Kebinekaan Global: Yuk, kita adakan hari pertukaran budaya di sekolah, di mana kita bisa berbagi tradisi dan praktik budaya masing-masing. Ini tidak hanya memperkaya pengalaman kita, tetapi juga menjadi dorongan semangat bagi siswa-siswa kita yang akan berkompetisi di World Scholar's Cup Global Round di Bangkok minggu depan. Semangat dan keberanian yang kita tunjukkan di acara tersebut akan menjadi bekal berharga untuk bersaing di tingkat internasional dan membawa nama baik Indonesia ke pentas dunia.
- Bernalar Kritis dan Apresiasi Prestasi: Mari kita aktif berdiskusi dan menganalisis isu-isu terkini serta masalah sosial dengan berbagai sudut pandang, agar kita bisa mengembangkan argumen yang baik. Kami juga ingin memberi apresiasi sebesar-besarnya kepada Irsy, yang baru saja meraih medali emas di Olimpiade Sains Nasional. Keberhasilan Irsy adalah contoh nyata dari potensi dan dedikasi siswa-siswa kita. Semangat dan pencapaian Irsy ini seharusnya memotivasi kita semua untuk terus berusaha dan meraih lebih banyak prestasi. Kita juga ingin merayakan sukses besar acara CAS pertama kita, "My My Mia Musical," yang merupakan pencapaian luar biasa. Ini adalah contoh konkret dari kreativitas dan kerja keras yang dapat memotivasi kita semua untuk terus berinovasi dan berkarya.
- Kreativitas: Ayo, kita berkarya dengan menggunakan bahan daur ulang atau ikut lokakarya menulis kreatif, menampilkan bakat kita sambil mempromosikan keberlanjutan lingkungan.
